

**South Dakota Board of Chiropractic Examiners Meeting

September 13, 2017**

The board meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m. The following members were present: Dr. Jeff Kramer, Dr. Jerrid Goebel, Dr. Kathleen Deutsch, Dr. Rick Odland along with Marcia Walter, Executive Director. Bev McCracken was given an excused absence.

Dr. Kramer welcomed Dr. Rick Odland as the new board member appointed by the Governor to complete the term of Dr. Dean Berg.
