Chairman Rosenboom called the meeting to order at 9:34 a.m. Roll call was taken and a quorum was determined.

Chairman Rosenboom asked for a motion to approve the minutes of April 27, 2017.

INFORMATIONAL REVISIONS FOR THE COMMISSION

17-SC-038 This revision removed a structure located on US85 3.6 N of Buffalo over Sheep Creek from a 2017 scour protection project (Sequence # 382, Page 100 in the 2017-2020 STIP Book) as the work was determined to be not needed on this structure after onsite inspections were conducted.

FY 2017 Minus \$16,000

Behm brought up to the Commission's desire to have a Transportation Commission meeting at another location this year. A Sioux Falls September 28 or October 26 meeting was suggested. The majority of the Commission members preferred the September date. Because of the roundup planned on September 29, it was suggested to move the meeting date to Wednesday, September 27, possibly in the afternoon with a visit to a construction site on Thursday morning.
