Dear Mr. Behm:

The following items are recommended for Commission consideration:

1. Abandonment (Tabled at April 26, 2018 meeting) – Codington County:

Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the following property acquired for highway purposes:

Lot AB1 in a portion of Lot H1 in the NE1/4 of Section 21, Township 119 North, Range 51 West of the 5th P.M., Codington County, South Dakota.

Said Lot AB1 contains 2.66 acres.

Lot H1 in the Northwest Quarter (NW1/4) of Section 22, Township 119 North, Range 51 West of the 5th P.M., Codington County, South Dakota.

Said Lot H1 contains 0.59 acre.

Former South Dakota Highway 20 formerly occupying portions of sections 14, 15, 22 and 23 of Township 119 North, Range 51 West of the 5th P.M., Codington County, South Dakota, as shown in attached Exhibit A.

The above described properties are located on the north side of current Hwy 20 near the community of South Shore. The properties are no longer needed for highway purposes and abandonment is recommended by DOT Watertown Area. (See attachment)

2. Abandonment (Tabled at March 29, 2018 meeting) – Minnehaha County

Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the following property acquired for highway right-of-way:

Tracts 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 of Norton Tracts Subdivision in the South Half (S1/2) of Section 3, Township 101 North, Range 49 West of the 5th P.M., Minnehaha County, South Dakota, except Highway right of way.

The above property is no longer needed for highway purposes and abandonment is recommended by DOT Sioux Falls Area. (See attachment)

3. Transfer (Correction of a Highway parcel legal description for the approved Transfer Resolution 2018-03.06) – Minnehaha County:

Request Transportation Commission approval to transfer the State's interest in a portion of South Dakota Highway 115 to the city of Sioux Falls the following property acquired for highway right-of-way more particularly described as:

Lot H1 in the West 109 feet of Lot 6 in Block 15 of Gale's Sioux Falls, Minnehaha County, South Dakota.

The Highway 115 right-of-way described above would be transferred to the city of Sioux Falls by Quit Claim Deed and the city of Sioux Falls would accept ownership, jurisdiction and maintenance responsibilities.

Sioux Falls Area DOT recommends the transfer.

4. Transfer – Minnehaha County:

Request Transportation Commission approval to transfer to the city of Sioux Falls the following property acquired for highway right-of-way:

The State's interest in portions of North Westport Avenue (East side I-29 service road) more particularly described as:

North Westport Avenue, from its intersection with South Dakota Highway 38 (Also known as West 60<sup>th</sup> Street) in Minnehaha County, south, to the 1/16<sup>th</sup> Line of the North 1/2 of the South West 1/4 of Section 6, Township 101 North, Range 49 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. Minnehaha County, South Dakota.

This resolution will complete a portion of the requirements of Agreement #710142 signed the city of Sioux Falls and the State of South Dakota, through its Department of Transportation, on June 25, 1991 Jurisdictional Exchange Agreement between the City of Sioux Falls and South Dakota Department of Transportation (Agreement No. 710142), together with the April 8, 1997 amendment thereto (Addendum No. 1), and

together with the May 5, 1998 amendment thereto (Addendum No.2) collectively referred to as "Exchange Agreement 710142", of a portion of North Westport Avenue (East side I-29 service road) not having yet been made of all the state of South Dakota's interests in real property, including without limitation, structures such as roadways, bridges, culverts, sidewalks, right-of-way fences, and all other fixtures and appurtenances (collectively referred to as "structures"), of North Westport Avenue, from its intersection with South Dakota Highway 38 (Also known as West 60<sup>th</sup> Street) in Minnehaha County to the 1/16<sup>th</sup> Line of the North 1/2 of the South West 1/4 of Section 6, Township 101 North, Range 49 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. Minnehaha County, South Dakota of North Westport Avenue will be transferred.

This resolution will complete the requirements of a portion of Exchange Agreement #710142. The highway right of way described above would be transferred to the city of Sioux Falls and the city of Sioux Falls would accept ownership, jurisdiction, operational and maintenance responsibilities of the above described right-of-way.

Sioux Falls Area DOT recommends disposal. (See attached layout)

5. Abandonment – Lawrence County

This resolution will abandon the temporary easements on Lawrence County Project NH-PH 0085(20)26, PCN 0555.

6. Abandonment – Lincoln County

This resolution will abandon the temporary easements on Lincoln County Project PH 0046(65)373, PCN 04HF.

7. Abandonment – Minnehaha County

This resolution will abandon the temporary easements on Minnehaha County Project P 0042(10)363, PCN 4458.


8. Abandonment – Union County


This resolution will abandon the temporary easements on Union County Project PH 0046(65)373, PCN 04HF.




