Dear Aeronautics Commissioners:

Greetings from Brookings! We have been busy over the winter break getting the simulator on location. I had to drive the trailer to Denver, CO to get the simulator installed in early December and then I flew home the next day. I went back out right before Christmas and we signed paperwork, completed the training and maintenance inspections as well as did a full functionality inspection on the sim and all worked beautifully! After a very long day of training in Denver I drove most the way home that night and finished out the trip just in time to make it home for Christmas. This project has been a large exercise in problem solving, from insurance, to what state vehicle to pull it with, to electrical loads, to who can use it has been a challenge, but we are paving the way and making process!

We have spent the last 30 days taking pictures to get the simulator trailer branded, and we are busy training the CFI's and senior students on how to use it. As of today we have put over 20 hours on the device and had close to 45 people try out the simulator, including students, CFI's, community members, school age students, and even a few transient pilots. We are still learning what it takes to operate it in the environment that we plan to use it and are scheduling visits as we speak. What we have learned is it will probably take 3-4 people to operate the device for a half day and a few more if we do a full day of operation.

We are in the process of scheduling this spring and summer and so far we will be busy!


