Our office received 149 pieces of artwork from ten different schools. This includes 2 private schools, 6 public schools and 2 homeschools for this year's annual art contest.

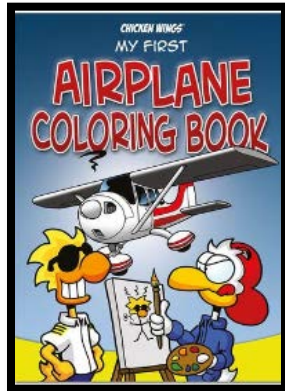

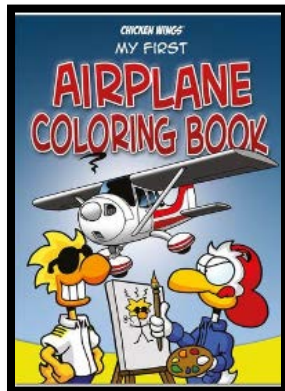

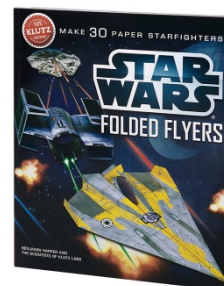

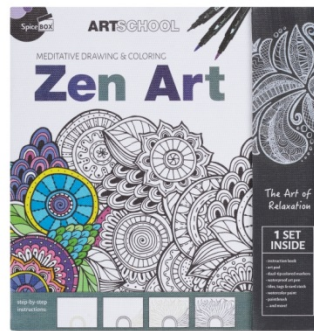

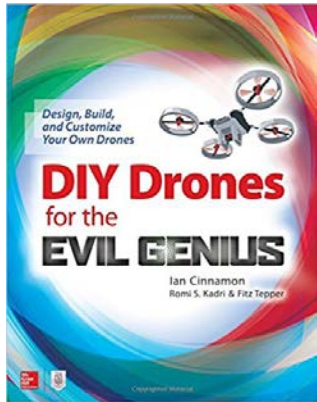
