

Public Involvement Plan – Request to Rename Harney Peak SD Board on Geographic Names

- December 22, 2014 Board Meeting
 - Present public involvement plan to board
 - No discussion on topic – just review of plan
- March 16th – Open the 45 day comment period on Harney Peak name
 - Press release issued
 - Notice sent to interested parties list which includes:
 - Black Hills & Other Interested Historical Societies
 - Custer & Pennington County Commissions
 - Custer & Pennington County Legislators
 - Minority Contacts
 - Interested Parties (individuals or groups who have asked to be on the list)
 - All SD Tribal Leaders & Tribal THPOs (Tribal Historic Preservation Officers)
 - All Tribes with interest in feature according to NAGPRA (Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act) list (as required by the US Board on Geographic Names) which is as follows:
 - Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes of the Fort Peck Indian Reservation, Montana
 - Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe of the Cheyenne River Reservation, South Dakota
 - Crow Creek Sioux Tribe of the Crow Creek Reservation, South Dakota
 - Lower Brule Sioux Tribe of the Lower Brule Reservation, South Dakota
 - Rosebud Sioux Tribe of the Rosebud Indian Reservation, South Dakota
 - Santee Sioux Nation, Nebraska
 - Standing Rock Sioux Tribe of North and South Dakota
 - Oglala Sioux Tribe of the Pine Ridge Reservation, South Dakota
 - Comment period to end on May 1, 2015
- April 27- May 8, 2015 Timeframe– Hold Public Board Meeting to take additional Public Comment
 - Issue Press Release to announce meeting locations week prior to meetings
 - Meetings in the following locations:
 - Martin – April 28th at 7pm
 - Custer – April 29th at 1:30pm
 - Rapid City – April 29th at 7pm
 - Pierre – May 6th at 1:30pm
- May 15, 2015 – Open Comment Period – Proposed Recommendation of the name of the feature out for 30 day for additional public comment about board decision
 - Send notice to all parties that received original notice
 - Send notice to any interested parties that submitted written comments (or oral comments with contact information)
 - Issue press release
 - Comment period to end on June 15, 2015
- June 22 – July 1, 2015 – Schedule Board Meeting to Review any additional comments and make final recommendation to US Board on Geographic Meetings
- July 1, 2015 – Send letter to US Board on Geographic Names with state board's recommendation
