

**MINUTES OF THE SOUTH DAKOTA ANNUAL WEED & PEST CONTROL COMMISSION MEETING  
FEBRUARY 17, 2016 – 1:30 PM

Chairman Lynn Diebert called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm, February 17, 2016.

Weed & Pest Coordinator Report was given by Brenda Sievers. Staff has been working weed and pest booths. Common mullein control was the biggest topic at the Black Hills Stock Show.

Weed & Pest Supervisor Report was given Ron Moehring. He talked about the good turnout at the shows and that common mullein control was the most asked about weed. He reported that there are 14 new weed supervisors this year.

District and agency reports were given by Duane Buckmeier, Craig Magedanz, Floyd Muntefering, Lynn Diebert,

Paul Coughlin, Neil VonEschen, Ron Thyen, Paul Johnson, and Brandon Beshears.

Dale Anderson gave the CAPS report on planned projects for 2016. Planned activities include a small grain survey, karnal bunt, gypsy moth detection, pine shoot beetle traps and Japanese beetle trapping. Mike Stenson reported on the bio-control project that is planned.

Amy Mesman gave the APHIS report, including grasshopper survey, gypsy moth survey and export certificates. Dave Hirsch from North Dakota is now supervising their office.

The annual meeting date was discussed and Brenda will try to get the meeting scheduled for the first week in April.


A motion was made by Paul Coughlin, to approve the bills for this meeting, Weed and Pest Conference and the
