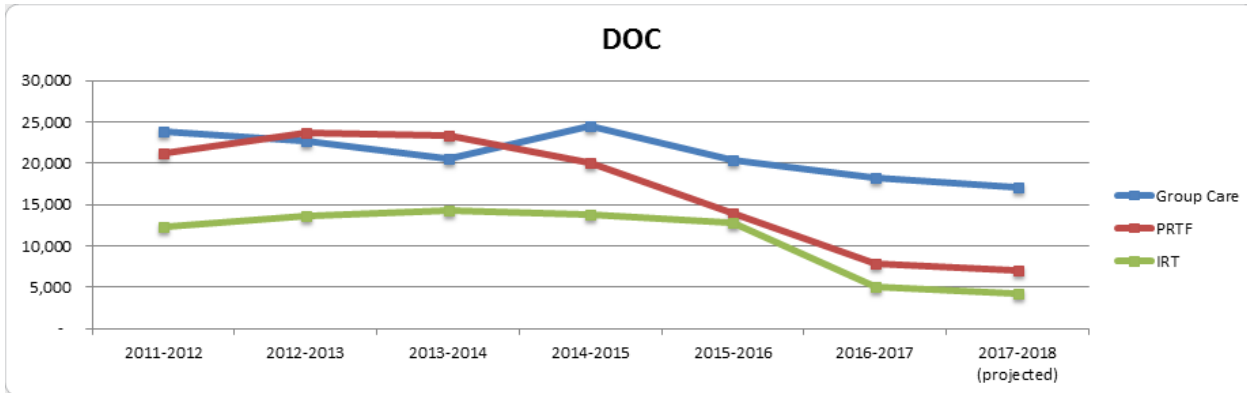




# South Dakota Association of Youth Care Providers
