OC17-018 – In the matter of the Complaint filed by Southeastern Electric Cooperative, Inc., (Southeastern) in Lennox, South Dakota against A One Company Pumping and Excavating (A One), Sioux Falls, South Dakota, for an incident occurring April 19, 2017 at 27111 Independence Avenue, Ste A in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

On August 24, 2017, Southeastern filed a complaint alleging A One was excavating without a locate ticket, working while locators were on site and continued working after hitting a utility.

The response deadline for A One is September 14, 2017.

Today, shall the Enforcement Panel of South Dakota One Call Notification Board find that there is probable cause A One violated any statute or rule under the jurisdiction of the Board, and if so shall a civil penalty be assessed?

OC17-019 – In the matter of the Complaint filed by Watertown Municipal Utilities (Watertown), Watertown, South Dakota against Cable Specialists, Inc. (Cable), Sioux Falls, South Dakota for an incident occurring August 24, 2017 at 502 E Kemp Avenue in Watertown, South Dakota.

On August 25, 2017, Watertown filed a complaint alleging a violation of 49-7A-5, beginning work before the 48 hour notice. Watertown is also alleging a violation of 20:25:03:05:03, not hand excavating within 18 inches of a marked facility.

The response deadline for Cable is September 14, 2017.

Today, shall the Enforcement Panel of South Dakota One Call Notification Board find that there is probable cause Cable violated any statute or rule under the jurisdiction of the Board, and if so shall a civil penalty be assessed?
