GAMING RULES:

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:01:01. Definitions. The effect of the amendment is to clarify drop box definition, delete the definition of free play and add a definition for non cashable promo play.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:06:02. Fee required with application. The effect of the amendment is to provide a fee for Commission approval of games and game variations.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:06:12. Application for approval of games. The effect of the new rule is to create an application process for new games or new variations of games.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:12.01:09. Persons not to bring their own cards, dice or chips. The effect of the amendment is to prohibit persons from bringing dice into a gaming location.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:12.01:19. Manned surveillance rooms. The effect of the new rule is to provide for manned surveillance rooms with house banked table games and craps.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:12.01:20. Use of licensed gaming tables for training of dealers. The effect of the new rule is to allow licensed gaming tables to be used for training purposes.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:12.01:21. Training licensed dealers. The effect of the new rule is to provide training for dealers of house banked table games, craps and roulette.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:14:01. Authorized games. The effect of this amendment is to authorize the games of craps, roulette and keno.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:14.01:01. Definitions. The effect of this amendment is to add craps and roulette to game tournaments.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:15:30.07. Variations of the play – Buster blackjack. The effect of the amendment is to add a free bonus feature to Buster Blackjack.

The reason for the change is to recognize a request by the originator of the game, CAYN Enterprises, Inc.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:15:30.14. Variations of the play – free bet blackjack. The effect of the new rule is to add a variation of blackjack known as free bet blackjack.

The reason for the rule is to recognize a request by the originator of the game, Scientific Games.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:16:15.02. The play – Three card poker. The reason for the rule is to add an optional six card bonus wager to three card poker.

The reason for the rule is to recognize a request by the originator of the game, Scientific Games.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:16:15.09. The play – Silverado Stud poker. The effect of the amendment is to add an optional four card bet.

The reason for the change is to recognize a request by the originator the game, CAYN Enterprises, Inc.

Proposed rule amendment. ARSD 20:18:18:15. Maintenance of slot machines. The effect of the amendment is to add craps and roulette components to associated equipment.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:19:09. Craps table – physical characteristics. The effect of this new rule is to establish requirements for craps tables.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:19:10. Dice – physical characteristics. The effect of this new rule is to establish the physical characteristics for dice.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:19:11. Dice – receipt, storage, inspection and removal from use. The effect of this new rule is to establish requirements for the use of dice.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:19:12. Dice – cancellation and destruction of dice. The effect of this new rule is to establish procedures for cancellation and destruction of dice.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:19:13. Roulette table – physical characteristics. The effect of the rule is to establish physical characteristics for roulette tables.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:19:14. Roulette balls. The effect of the rule is to establish the physical characteristics for roulette balls.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:20:13. Nonvalue roulette chips. The effect of the rule is to establish criteria for nonvalue roulette chips.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:22:12. Adjusted gross revenue computations. The effect of the amendment is to clarify computation of adjusted gross revenue.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:22:23. ~~Free play items~~ Non cashable promo play. The effect of the amendment is clarify the use of non cashable promo play.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:29:03. Areas requiring surveillance during hours of operation. The effect of the amendment is to provide for surveillance of craps and roulette games.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:29:07. Surveillance equipment malfunctions. The effect of the amendment is to clarify procedures regarding surveillance equipment malfunctions.

The reason for the change is to provide enhanced security measures and to further enact rules to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:29:13. Surveillance room. The effect of the amendment is to require that only licensed persons enter surveillance rooms.

The reason for the change is to provide enhanced security measures and to further enact rules to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rules chapter: ARSD 20:18:32:01 through 20:18:32:18. Keno Chapter. The effect is to set forth a new chapter of rules for the play of Keno.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rules chapter: ARSD 20:18:33:01 through 20:18:33:11. Craps Chapter. The effect is to set forth a new chapter of rules for the play of Craps.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed new rules chapter: ARSD 20:18:34:01 through 20:18:34:11. Roulette Chapter. The effect is to set forth a new chapter of rules for the play of Roulette.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

Proposed rule change: Appendix A, Gaming Internal Control and Revenue Reporting Manual, Accounting Function, Section 535.5. The effect of the change is to clarify and increase minimum bankroll cash reserves and cash reserve requirements, to include craps, roulette and keno, and bad bet liability.

The reason for the change is to comply with and enact laws passed during the 2015 legislative session.

After the hearing, the Commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rule changes. The Commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
