Board member Mike Albertson temporarily left the meeting at 8:39 a.m.

**Case 09-06      Competency and Professional Conduct - Board adopted the OHE's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law at its 11/21/14 meeting. Stay of Board's order granted while under appeal. Brief filed 03/10/15, Boards' reply brief due 04/20/15.**

The Investigative committee gave a brief update on the status of this case. Appeal of the case is currently in progress, with a stay on the Order of the Board. The licensee's legal counsel has filed a brief and the Board's legal counsel has 45 days to file a reply.

Board member Mike Albertson rejoined the meeting at 8:44 a.m.

**Case 14-04      Failure to report Disciplinary Action - AR. - Rescheduled Hearing Dates of February were not accepted. Investigative Committee is working on alternatives.**

Staff Attorney Arnold is drafting a negotiated settlement agreement. If the negotiated settlement agreement is rejected; a hearing will be scheduled.

**Case 14-05      Failure to report Disciplinary Action - AR. - (Hearing held on 01/14/15; final decision sent)**

The Board held a hearing on this case at the January 14, 2015 board meeting. A final decision was sent to licensee on March 3, 2015. Licensee has 30 days to respond.

**Case 15-03      Practice without CoA - AR.**

Draft of a negotiated settlement agreement is being worked on.

**Case 15-04      Practice without CoA - PE.**

An assurance of voluntary compliance has been accepted, signed, and payment of the fine has been made.

**Case 15-05      Practice without CoA - PE.**

A complaint is in the process of being sent to the licensee.

**Case 15-06      Audit - Failure to comply with PDH requirements - LS**

A complaint is in the process of being sent to the licensee.

**Case 15-07      Renewal with Discipline - Practice outside area of competency - PE**

A complaint is in the process of being sent to the licensee.

**Case 15-08      Unlicensed Practice - PE**

An assurance of voluntary compliance was negotiated and has been signed by the licensee. Board accepted the document and the Chairman signed the document. An administrative fee will need to be paid as part of the compliance.

This case is in the investigative stage and it is hopeful that an assurance of voluntary compliance will be negotiated.

Investigative committee is currently investigating this case to determine if any disciplinary action needs to be taken.

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## AGENDA ITEM #5 OLD BUSINESS

### Action Items - reports

**Item 1: Seals; Guideline Document - Electronic Plans Distribution.** The board discussed this topic and recommends that the final draft of the guide document along with the proposed law changes be approved and distributed to collaterals for final review. The Board approved the housekeeping revisions to the statutes at the January board meeting and will forward these along with the other statute changes after review is completed and they are then finalized by the Board.

**Item 2: Discipline Questions on Application Not Clear.** Item is complete and form updates are now on the website. However, work is still being done on the language to make them clearer. Revisions will be posted as they become available.

**Item 3: All licensees must be linked to a CoA to practice.** The Board discussed this item and determined that it is currently adequately addressed in statute. The Board recommends removal of this item from the action items list.

**Item 4: Cross Practice in Construction Administration.** The Board reviewed and approved the final draft of statute revisions. The Board recommends that these changes be disseminated to professional associations for input before sending to LRC.

**Item 5: Building Officials Guide.** The Board has reviewed a draft document produced by board member Williams. The consensus of the Board is that this document needs to be finalized and then published to the website.

**Item 6: Rewrite Petroleum Release Exam and review experience required for Assessor and Remediator.** The Board is currently waiting for input from the state regulatory agency.

**Item 7: Board Policy on early testing and on CoA required.** The Board discussed this item and determined that it is already adequately addressed in current statutes and the Board will deal with any problems arising from early PE testing as they occur. The Board recommends that this item be removed from the action items list.

**Item 8: Possible ways to make use of reserve funds.** The Board discussed ways the Board's reserve funds can be utilized to advance the technical professions. Suggestions were proposed and Staff Attorney Arnold will research and advise the Board on any legal restrictions on how these reserve funds can be used.

Add **Item 9: Pursue an outreach to the associations of counties, county commissioners, and/or rural permitting agents to educate them on requirements for obtaining building / A&E services for health, safety, and welfare of the public. This may include speaking at meetings.**

### Board Policies

The Board discussed the draft policies letter, which were prepared by board member Neugebauer and determined that both policy 1 and 2 are already adequately addressed in current statute. The Board recommends that this item be removed from the action items list.

### Monuments Question

Question has to do with roadway construction projects that may disturb or destroy property corner monuments. Some land surveyors do not want to place their survey cap on replacement pins due to original pins being destroyed or disturbed. The surveyor members of the Board are currently investigating this matter. Upon completion of that investigation, it is hoped that the Board will be able to reach a consensus on the appropriate answers to the questions which were received by the Board.

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## **AGENDA ITEM #6 NEW BUSINESS**

### **NCEES - PS examination moving to CBT**

Discussion was briefly held on the transition of the Principles and Practice of Surveying exam from a pencil and paper exam to a computer-based exam. Registration for the computer-based Principles and Practice of Surveying exam will begin in mid-2016 and the first available appointments for this exam in CBT format will begin October 1, 2016.

### **NCARB - Draft Resolutions 2015**

The Board briefly discussed the NCARB draft resolution 2015-A Revision of the Alternatives to the Education Requirement for Certification, which have to do with NCARB's BEA program requirements. The consensus of the Board is to support this resolution.

### **Supreme Court Decision on the Tooth Whitening Case**

The U.S. Supreme Court issued a ruling concerning the case of the North Carolina Dental Board vs. the Federal Trade Commission. In this case, the North Carolina Dental Board issued a ruling that only licensed dentists were legally authorized to offer and provide teeth whitening services since such procedures could have an impact on the health and welfare of the public. The Federal Trade Commission filed a complaint that was heard by an administrative law judge alleging that the actions by the dental board were a restraint of trade in violation of antitrust laws.

The dental board appealed the decision to the Court of Appeals which affirmed the decision of the administrative law judge. The dental board then requested a review by the Supreme Court based on the constitutionality of a federal agency being legally able to overrule the actions of a state legislated body. The Supreme Court agreed to hear the case based on the question of constitutional authority.

Several national associations including NCEES filed amicus briefs with the Supreme Court to provide arguments in support of the dental board's case. The prominent concerns being the liability that boards may be subject to if their actions were in danger of being overturned by a federal agency, as well as the potential problem of getting individuals to volunteer for service on a board in the future if this liability exists. The Supreme Court affirmed the decision of the Court of Appeals.

Staff Attorney Arnold is looking at this case and the decision for potential implications for state boards on how they regulate their professions.

### **Grading Certifications**

The Colorado Board posted a notice on their website called, "Grading Certifications and Grading Design Statements". This notice reads as follows:

Please be advised that the Colorado State Board of Licensure for Architects, Professional Engineers, and Professional Land Surveyors ("Board") considers grading certifications and grading design statements that include language stating or implying that the grading design accurately reflects the design intent of an approved grading plan, that the grading will or will not cause storm water damage, or that the lot will drain adequately to constitute the practice of engineering.

As the design, evaluation, and analysis of grading and/or drainage plans are considered the practice of engineering, these plans should be prepared by an engineer utilizing data provided by a professional land surveyor. Preparing grading and drainage plans are not within the scope of the practice of land surveying. If a land surveyor makes a certification on a grading or drainage plan, it should be limited to determined elevations of land parcels and must not contain statements of engineering design, evaluation, or analysis.

An individual who, without being licensed as a Colorado professional engineer, prepares, signs, or seals such a grading design statement violates state statute and may be subject to legal action by the Board, including but not limited to a "cease and desist" order or injunction. Professional land surveyors who are not also licensed as a Colorado professional engineer are not authorized to engage in the practice of engineering.

The following is an example of a grading certificate or statement that may be signed or sealed by a person who is not a licensed professional engineer: "The grading for the lot shown hereon accurately reflects the design of the approved area grading plan prepared by [engineering firm]."

The South Dakota Board discussed this Colorado notice. The position of the South Dakota Board is that Land Surveyors should not be creating or developing grading and drainage plans, as this would be included within the practice of engineering.

### **Nebraska Continuing Education model for web-based programs**

The consensus of the Board is that the Nebraska Continuing Education Model for Web-Based Programs is a good idea and deserves further consideration by the Board, as long as it is in general agreement with NCEES Continuing Professional Competency manual and procedures.

### **NCARB - IDP proposal**

NCARB has developed a proposal for the creation of an Accelerated Path to Architectural Licensure system whereby Architectural students can be granted licensure upon graduation from an accredited University. Based on this proposal, NCARB's Licensure Task Force and staff would work with schools to develop a program that integrates completion of the IDP and ARE into their curriculum, thus facilitating licensure upon graduation.

### **Review of Legislation: SB01 & others**

The Board briefly discussed several bills that could affect the professions.

### **Tennessee - Standard of Care for Fire Sprinkler System Design**

Board briefly discussed this topic and will keep this document on file for future reference.

### **American Board of Architecture Statement**

NCARB would like all Boards to be advised and aware of an entity calling itself the "American Board of Architecture". This entity is seeking endorsements necessary to establish itself as an accrediting body of architecture schools. It appears to be developing what it purports will be its' own architectural test. The ability to confer a license, including requirements for meeting educational criteria, is solely determined by the state and territorial governments of the United States. The legitimacy of accrediting organizations is determined by state and national departments of education. This entity also appears to be developing a new architectural school in California called the Adroit School of Architecture. This school is making claims on its website that NCARB statements are misleading and is using names and logos of other organizations without permission in a way that implies these organizations endorse or approve of the school.

### **ACCA Charge 2 report motion**

The Board discussed a pending motion being brought to NCEES regarding structural engineering practice and the current approaches to structural engineering regulation. This matter may be brought forward for a vote at the next NCEES meeting.


