- Case 09-06** Competency and Professional Conduct - Board adopted the OHE's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law at the 11/21/14 meeting. Stay of Board's order granted while under appeal. Brief filed 03/10/15, Board's reply Brief due 04/20/15. Oral arguments heard 05/11/15.

This case will be sent back to the hearing examiner for further review and a final decision.

- Case 14-04** Failure to report Disciplinary Action - AR - Rescheduled Hearing Dates of February not accepted. Investigative Committee is working on alternatives.

Hearings have been scheduled and a final offer has been made to the licensee. Licensee made small changes to the final offer, which is now being reviewed by the Board's legal counsel.

- Case 14-05** Failure to report Disciplinary Action - AR. Final order signed. Certified receipt returned signed 03/17/15; Fine was due to be paid 03/29/15; report due on projects 04/12/15.

License has been suspended pending compliance with the final order.

- Case 15-03** Practice without CoA - AR

A voluntary assurance agreement is in the process of being sent to the licensee.

- Case 15-05** Practice without CoA - PE

The Investigative Committee should have more information on this case by the next board meeting.

- Case 15-06** Audit - Failure to comply with PDH requirements - LS

A hearing will be scheduled in conjunction with the next board meeting.

- Case 15-07** Renewal with Discipline - Practice outside area of competency - PE

The Investigative Committee should have more information on this case by the next board meeting.

- Case 15-09** Business Entity allowing unlicensed practice

The investigative committee requires more information from the documents in question to make a decision and should have more information after the documents are received and reviewed.

AGENDA ITEM #5 OLD BUSINESS

Action Items - reports:

Item 1: Seals; Guideline Document - Electronic Plans Distribution. Item is in progress. A final draft of the seals guideline document and the proposed rules and statute changes were distributed and approved at the last board meeting. The board sent this final draft to the various constituent organizations and interested individuals for review. No objections to this final draft were received. Therefore the Board recommends moving forward with the updated seals guideline document as well as the proposed rules and statute changes.

Item 2: Discipline Questions on Application Not Clear. Item is complete and form updates are now on the website. However, work is still being done on the language to make them clearer. The language is being reviewed by the Board's legal counsel. Revisions will be posted as they become available.

Item 3: Cross Practice in Construction Administration. Item is in progress. The Board reviewed and approved the proposed laws and statute revisions at the last board meeting. The Board recommends that Action Item #3 be combined with Action Item #1 and also recommends moving forward with these proposed rules and statute changes.

Item 4: Building Officials Guide. Item is in progress. The Board previously reviewed the draft document produced by board member Williams. Board member Williams will review changes to this draft document and will coordinate with building officials on their input to the document.

Item 5: Rewrite Petroleum Release Exam and review experience required for Assessor and Remediator. Item is in progress. The Board is currently waiting for input from the state regulatory agencies responsible for regulating the field of Petroleum Release.

Item 6: Possible ways to make use of reserve funds. The Board proposed a few suggestions on ways the Board's reserve funds can be used to advance the technical professions. Staff Attorney Arnold will research and advise the Board on how these reserve funds can legally be spent.

Item 7: Outreach to association of counties, county commissioners, and/or rural permitting agents to educate them on requirements for obtaining building / A&E services for health, safety, and welfare of the public (letter to be sent every 4 years). The Board and legal counsel are looking at this to determine how these agencies can be educated on the state's requirements for determining whether or not A&E services are required.

NCEES - PS examination moving to CBT

The last paper and pencil PS exam will be on April 2016.

NCARB - Draft Resolutions 2015

Mike Armstrong, CEO of NCARB spoke to the Board on NCARB's draft resolutions for 2015, which cover three resolutions: 2015-1 Revision of the Alternatives to the Education and Experience Requirements for NCARB Certification, 2015-2 Revision of the Requirements for Certification of Foreign Architects, and 2015-3 Bylaws Amendment - Modifications to the Qualifications of Public Director on Council Board of Directors. These draft resolutions will be voted on by member boards at the NCARB Annual Business Meeting.

Mike Armstrong spoke to the Board giving a brief synopsis of each of these resolutions.

2015-1 Revision of the Alternatives to the Education and Experience Requirements for NCARB Certification: Addresses the ability of licensed architects not having a degree from a program accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) to obtain an NCARB certificate. The path for these licensees to obtain the certificate, by acquiring additional experience beyond licensure and IDP requirements in their home jurisdiction, is an alternative contained within the Certification Guidelines currently known as the Broadly Experienced Architect (BEA) program. Draft resolutions to overhaul the BEA have focused on removing fee and time barriers, automating a reporting system, and making the process more objective. At the same time, ongoing discussion has focused on assuring that the pursuit of a NAAB-accredited degree is incentivized and valued as a preferred path to satisfying education requirements for licensure. Our resolution drafts have consistently asserted that the core hours contained in the streamlined Intern Development Program (IDP) constitute a viable means of framing requirements for additional experience, in lieu of education, in the case of licensed architects without a NAAB-accredited degree.

2015-2 Revision of the Requirements for Certification of Foreign Architects: A Certification Guidelines amendment to modify the Broadly Experienced Foreign Architect (BEFA) program, which provides a path for foreign licensed architects to receive an NCARB certificate, to require completion of the IDP and all divisions of the ARE.

2015-3 Bylaws Amendment - Modifications to the Qualifications of Public Director on Council Board of Directors: A Bylaws amendment to adjust the qualifications for the NCARB Board's Public Director, drawing nominations from the pool of sitting public members on our Member Boards.

**Supreme Court Decision on the North Carolina Dental Board vs. the Federal Trade Commission
NSPE - newsletter on the Virginia Supreme Court's Decision on Liability**

The Governor's office has created a task force to study the Supreme Court Decision and to determine how this will affect our state licensing Boards.

Grading Certifications and Grading Design Statements

The consensus of the Board is that what Colorado is doing on the issue of grading certifications does not really apply to the way the grading certifications are done in South Dakota, so this is a non-issue.

NE Continuing Education model for web-based programs

This item describes how the Nebraska Board is developing a policy that address the amount of web-based Continuing Education Hours a licensee can claim during a renewal period. The Board believes that this is a good model and recommends adding it to the action items list for further review and monitoring and for possible adoption in the future.

NCARB - IDP proposal

Mike Armstrong spoke to the Board giving a brief synopsis on the NCARB IDP proposal for reducing IDP hours.

Gene Fennell, President of SD Chapter AIA spoke to the Board on the NCARB IDP proposal and AIA's concerns and position on this proposal.

ACCA Charge 2

The ACCA Charge 2 involves the licensing of structural engineers. NCEES is studying the issue of structural engineering practice and its method of regulation, summarizing the current approaches to structural engineering regulation, engaging the structural engineering community, and making recommendations for revisions to the Model Law and Model Rules, if deemed appropriate.

The Board briefly discussed each of the above topics.

The final report of the Task Force recommends a simple solution: restrict the role of regulation to the title “architect”, which should only apply to licensed individuals. The Task Force recommended that any title held by those pursuing licensure does not need to be regulated. In other words, it is recommended that NCARB discontinue the use of the word intern, intern-architect, or any other regulatory “title” describing those pursuing licensure. Further, architect emeritus is an acceptable term because it identifies those who have obtained a license but are no longer practicing, thus providing appropriate notice to the public.
