Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in City Hall, 102 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota, on Thursday, November 17, 2016, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered:

GAMING RULES: 20:18:15:30.03, 20:18:15:30.16, 20:18:16:15.03,
20:18:16:15.21, 20:18:29:05, 20:18:29:10.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:15:30.03. Variations of the Play – 21+3. The effect of the amendment is to add pay tables to the existing game.

The reason for the amendment is to clarify the payment of wagers through approved pay tables.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:15:30.16. Variations of the Play – Bust Bonus. The effect of the new rule is to add a variation to the game of blackjack known as Bust Bonus.

The reason for the new rule is to recognize a request from the originator of the game, Galaxy Gaming, Inc., and from the Silverado/Franklin Casino.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:16:15.03. The play – Let it ride and let it ride bonus including three card bonus optional side bet or progressive optional side bet. The effect of the amendment is to clarify that wagers may not exceed posted table bet limits.

The reason for the amendment is to recognize current betting limits.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:16:15.21. The play – High Card Flush. The effect of the new rule is to provide for a variation of the play of poker known as High Card Flush.

The reason for the new rule is to recognize a request from the game's originator, Galaxy Gaming, Inc., and from the Silverado/Franklin Casino.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:29:05. Slot machines with award capability of \$12,000 or greater. The effect of the amendment is to provide that closed

circuit surveillance of slot machines is required for machines that have awards of \$12,000 or greater.

The reason for the amendment is to provide for appropriate security and to protect the public's interest that gaming is conducted fairly.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:29:10. Number of recorders. The effect of the amendment is to require at least one video recorder within licensee surveillance systems.

The reason for the amendment is to recognize advances in technology and to provide appropriate security to ensure gaming is conducted fairly.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rule changes may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Commission on Gaming, 445 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, 57501. Materials sent by mail must reach the Commission on Gaming by Tuesday, November 15, 2016, to be considered. However, the Commission requests that all written comments be received by Friday, November 11, 2016, to allow for adequate consideration prior to the hearing.

After the hearing, the Commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rule changes. The Commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to any individual with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Please notify the Commission on Gaming at least 48 hours before the public hearing if you have special needs for which special arrangements must be made.
