The minutes to the October 23, 2014 commission meeting were presented to the board. Upon review Vice President Rogers moved to approve the minutes as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Hansen. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report for October, November and December 2014 were presented and reviewed by the commission. Vice President Rogers moved that these reports be approved as presented. Seconded by Commissioner McCaskell. Motion carried.

The bills paid checklist for October, November and December 2014 were presented and reviewed by the commission. Vice President Rogers moved that these reports be approved as presented. Seconded by Commissioner McCaskell. Motion carried.

The applications received record for October, November and December 2014 were presented and reviewed by the commission. Commissioner McCaskell moved that this report be approved as presented. Seconded by Vice President Rogers. Motion carried.

The commission reviewed the quarterly inspection report for Inspectors Borth, Leuning, Johnson, Steen and Healy. Upon review, Commissioner McCaskell moved that this report be approved as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Hansen. Motion carried.

Ken Melius, SD Assn PHCC informed the commission that continuing education information for 2015 is ready and letters have been sent out for registrations for this year's continuing education to be held in March.

Matt Marciniak, IAPMO Mid-West Region Manager spoke to the commission about Minnesota's adoption of the 2012 UPC Code and progress with their process.

Director Richards presented the commission with an application for plumbing contractor licensure for Rylan Ojala of Lake Norden. Upon review Vice President Rogers moved to deny application due to lack of experience time requirements. Seconded by Commissioner McCaskell. Motion carried.

Director Richards presented material from Endot Traceable Tubing for review. No action taken at this time.

Discussion was held on the Purple Primer requirement of the code. Guests Brad Bilka, Donovan Williamson and Chad Erlenbusch were present to discuss the purple primer code enforcement.

Upon discussion, Vice President Rogers moved that the commission hold a public hearing in conjunction with the commission's next regular meeting, April 23, 2015, to allow Unpurple Primer in addition to Purple Primer for PVC applications. It was explained that Unpurple Primer is a primer that has a special purple dye that when applied appears clear but the purple color can be revealed by a UV flashlight. Seconded by Commissioner McCaskell. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the date of the next quarterly meeting of the commission. Vice President Rogers moved that the next meeting be held in Pierre on Thursday, April 23, 2015. Seconded by Commissioner Hansen. Motion carried.

There being no further business Vice President Rogers moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Hansen. Motioned carried.
