NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of SDCL 1-26, particularly 1-26-4, thereof, and by virtue of the authority contained in SDCL 36-25-14 and SDCL 36-25-15, the State Plumbing Commission Will hold a public hearing in the Governor's Inn Conference Room, 700 West Sioux Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota on the 21st day of July, 2016 at 11:00 AM to amend existing rules.

The proposed rules to amend are ARSD 20:53:06:01 and 20:54:02:01. The effect of these rules is to exempt Class 1 and above certified water and wastewater operators from the commission's sewer and water licensing requirements and to replace the 2009 edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code with the 2015 edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code.

The reason for the proposed rules is to continue to insure that the construction, installation, and maintenance of plumbing in buildings in the state be safe, sanitary and such so as to safeguard the public's health.

Interested persons may submit oral or written arguments at the time of the hearing or may submit written arguments to the State Plumbing Commission, 308 South Pierre Street, Pierre, South Dakota 57501 prior to the 21st day of July, 2016.
