The plan was developed over a year and a half and sought to engage in a more supportive, collaborative process with this iteration of the plan to help schools provide the best opportunities for their students. The draft was finalized over a month ago. Since that time, it is a different world. The plan is still relevant as it moves forward. The plan is in response to federal requirements.

Questions by the board:

How often do we rewrite the plan? Scheibe responded that there is a new plan every four years, but it may be updated during the interim.

Motion by Schallenkamp and second by Guffin to approve the Perkins State Plan as presented. Roll call vote. All present voted in favor. Voting aye: Guffin, Heineman, Herman, Schallenkamp, Sly, Wagner and Westra. Motion carried.

Lori Wagner stated that due to the pandemic that e-learning in South Dakota is expanding and developing resources for educators across South Dakota.
