36	about non-traditional paths to help students complete their degrees and enter the workforce.

39	brief presentation on the DOES' work focusing on K-12 student success. Scheibe noted the		
40	name change of her division adding an emphasis on Student Success. DOE's focus is to make		
41	sure that students are equipped with skills to succeed to graduation, and to succeed after		
42	graduation, whether that is to post-secondary programs or directly to the workforce.
