<u>CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL</u>: Vice Chairman Merriman called the meeting to order. The roll was called, and a quorum was present.

Vice Chairman Merriman announced that the meeting was streaming live on SD.net, a service of South Dakota Public Broadcasting.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM APRIL 20, 2020 MEETING</u>: Motion by Willett, seconded by Snyder, to approve the minutes from the April 20, 2020, State Emergency Response Commission meeting. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>ELECTIONS</u>: Motion by Snyder to nominate Dustin Willett as chairman, seconded by Titze. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion carried with Pitz, Snyder, Titze, Leesch, McIntosh, and Merriman voting aye. Willett abstained.

Motion by Willett to nominate Paul Merriman as vice chairman, seconded by Titze. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>FEDERAL UPDATES</u>: Fran Santagata provided updates on the CFATS Program and other activities of Homeland Security.

State Emergency Response Commission June 29, 2020, Meeting Minutes

<u>WESTERN STATES SERC</u>: Dustin Willett gave an overview of the Western States Conference held in Denver in January. Trish Kindt discussed foam containing PFAS. DENR will collect and properly dispose of it. Paul Merriman said information has been sent to all fire chiefs.

Willett also mentioned the EPA has a TERA system. One of the new guidelines for RMP facilities is to have a tri-annual exercise with local fire department first responders teams.

The SERC requested that staff provide an update on RMP facilities training at the next meeting.

<u>HMEP GRANTS, TRAINING AND PLANNING REPORT:</u> Tina Titze, Office of Emergency Management, stated that she did not receive the report, but will email it to everyone after the meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: None.

OTHER BUSINESS: Aaron Leesch, new SERC member, briefed the commission about his background.

The next SERC meeting is tentatively set for September 15, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. in Spearfish during the Emergency Management Conference. It was discussed to possibly do it over DDN or teleconference.
