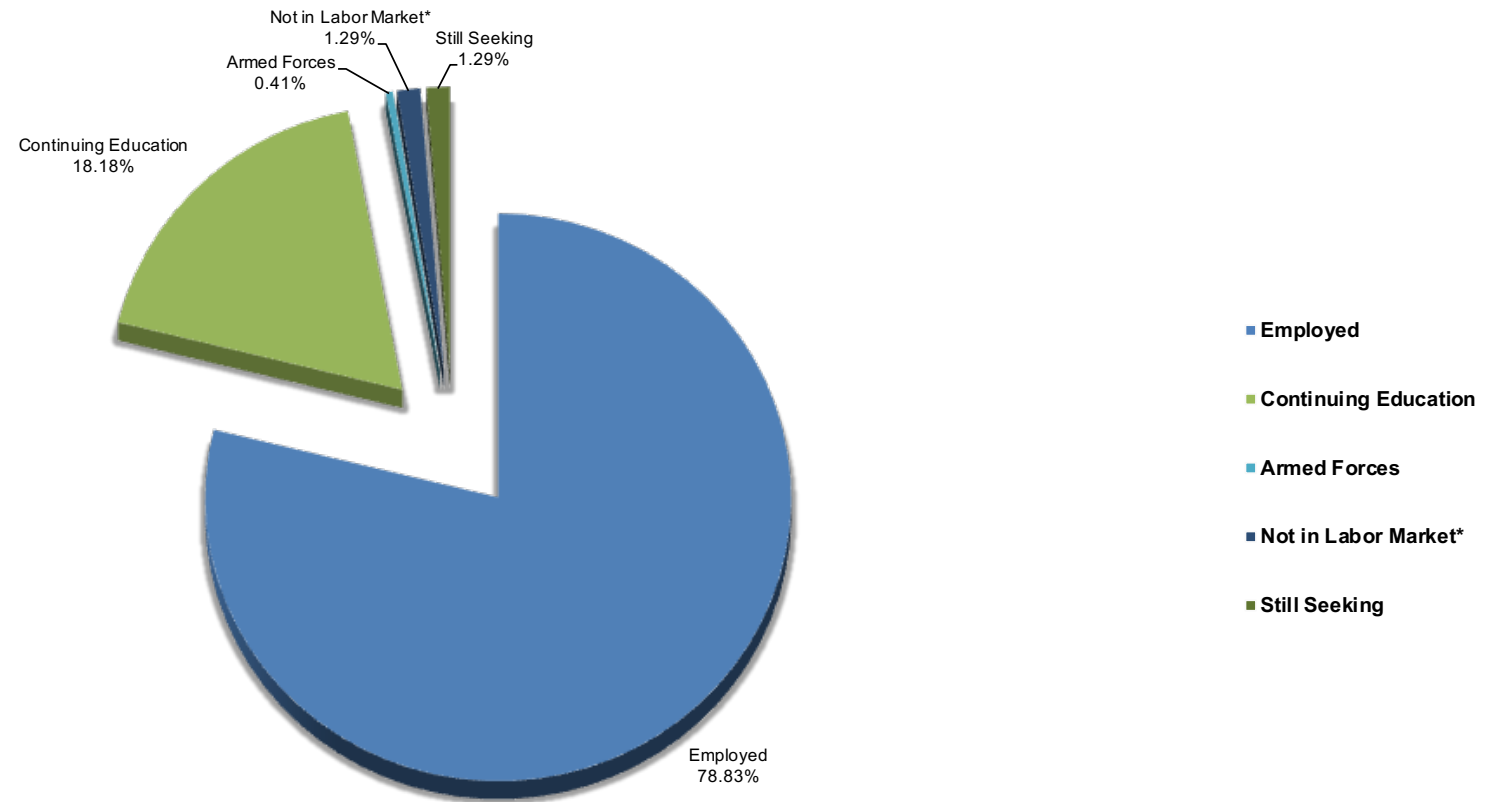
2019 Graduate Placement Report Process:
