South Dakota Board of Technical Education Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held by teleconference on August 18, 2020, at 9:30 am CST to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered

§§ 24:59:02 (Postsecondary technical funding distribution).

The effect of the rules will be to update and clarify language related to the South Dakota Board of Technical Education's set-aside funds, formula for funding, and "technical institute" to "technical college" name change.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is to streamline administrative processes related to fund distribution to the technical colleges and update language in response to the recent "institute" to "college" name change.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may appear in-person at the hearing or mail them to the South Dakota Board of Technical Education; Attn: Scott DesLauriers; 800 Governors Drive, Pierre, SD 57501. Material sent by mail must reach the Board of Technical Education by August 13, 2020, to be considered.
