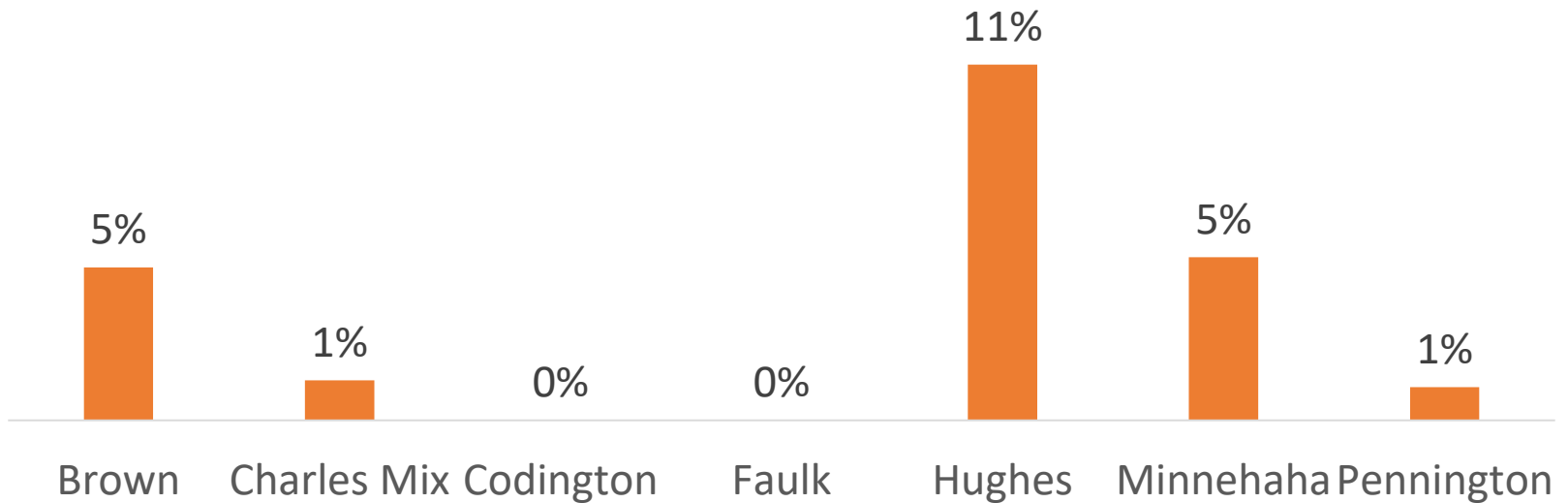

Nearly 10,000 screenings done across 7 jails in 5 months

Total	9617	100%

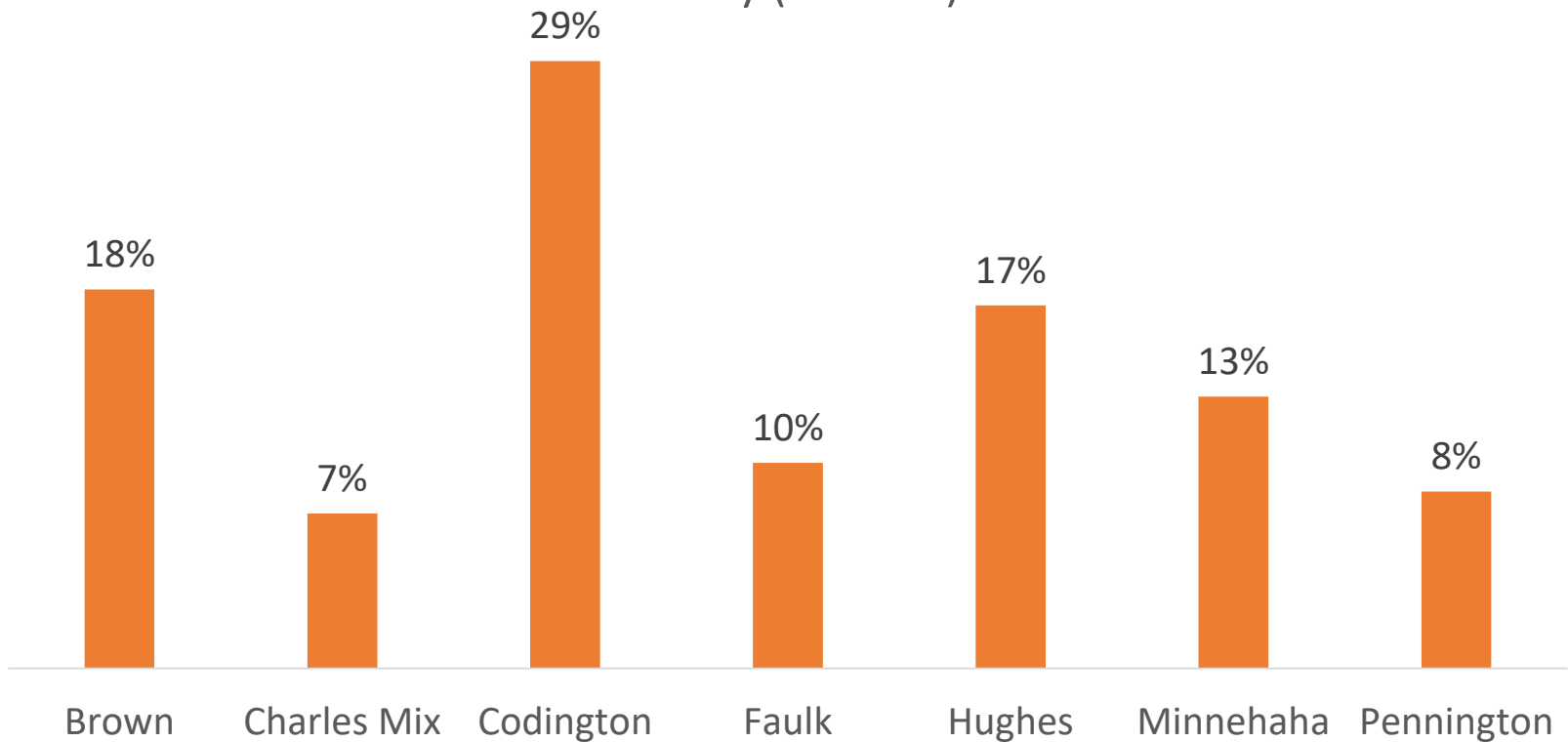
3% refusal rate (292 of 9617) across 7 jails

Screening Refusal Rates by County (N=9617)



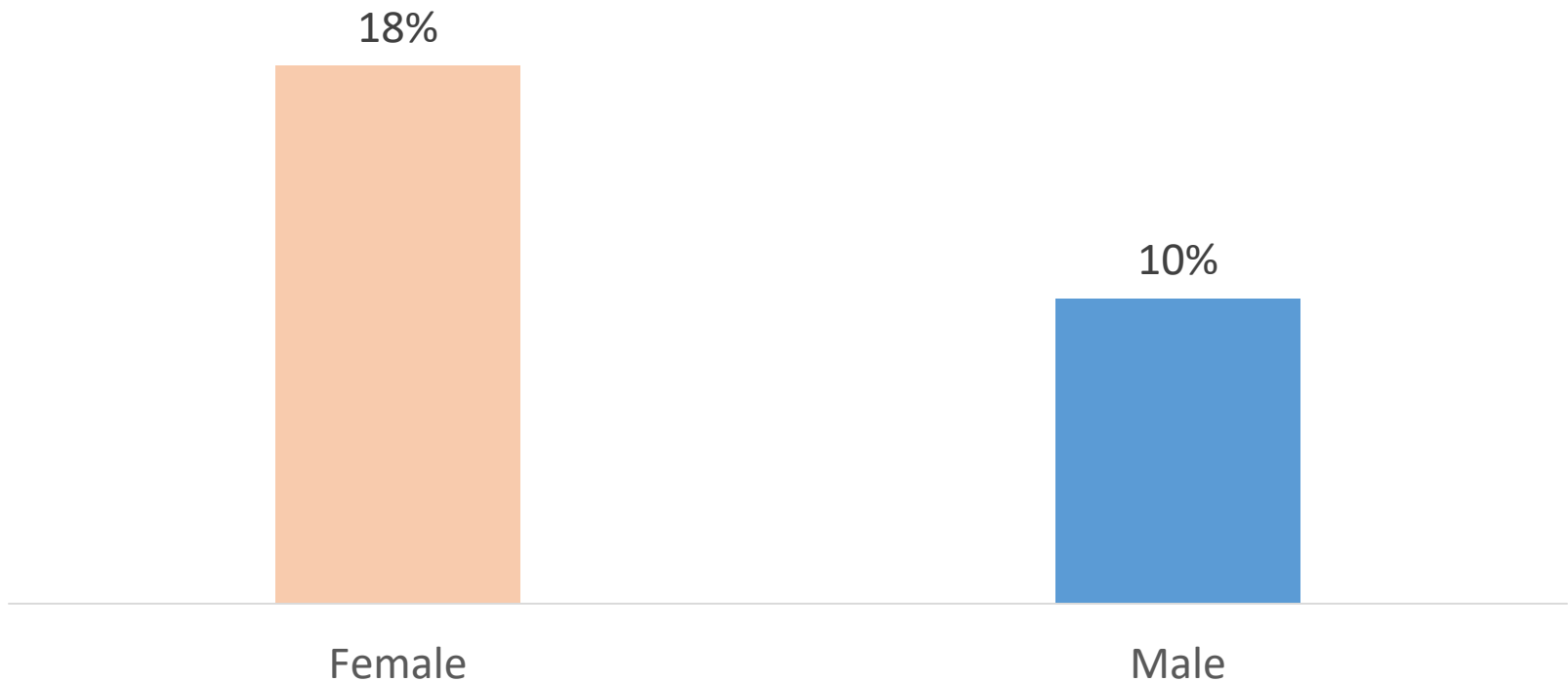
13% of the screenings across 7 jails indicated need for assessment

Nearly 1 in 5 female screenings indicated a need for assessment, compared to 1 in 10 male screenings
