### Agenda Item: Birth to Three Program and Head Start Collaboration

- Crystal Goeden, Education Program Specialist presented on Birth to Three. Birth to Three is a federal
  program serving infants from 36 months of age with developmental delays. Some of the services the
  Program pays for is speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, special instruction, assistive
  technology, family training, counseling, family transportation. Birth to Three is the payor of last resort
  for these services.
- Jennifer Kampmann, Education Program Specialist presented on the professional development part of Birth to Three. The professional development for home visits is family centered and builds parents competence and confidence. Birth to Three uses a Bright Beginnings model that is a routine based home visit to help families achieve the multiplier effect.
- Jodi Berscheid, Education Program Specialist from the Head Start Collaboration office presented an overview of the beginnings of Head Start to current activities.

- Linda Turner provided an overview of the legislative issues related to the Department of Education for 2024.
- IDEA Application and budget was discussed. The Part B and Part C grant application is open for public notice for 60 days. The grant is open for public comment from April 1, 2024, to April 30, 2024.
