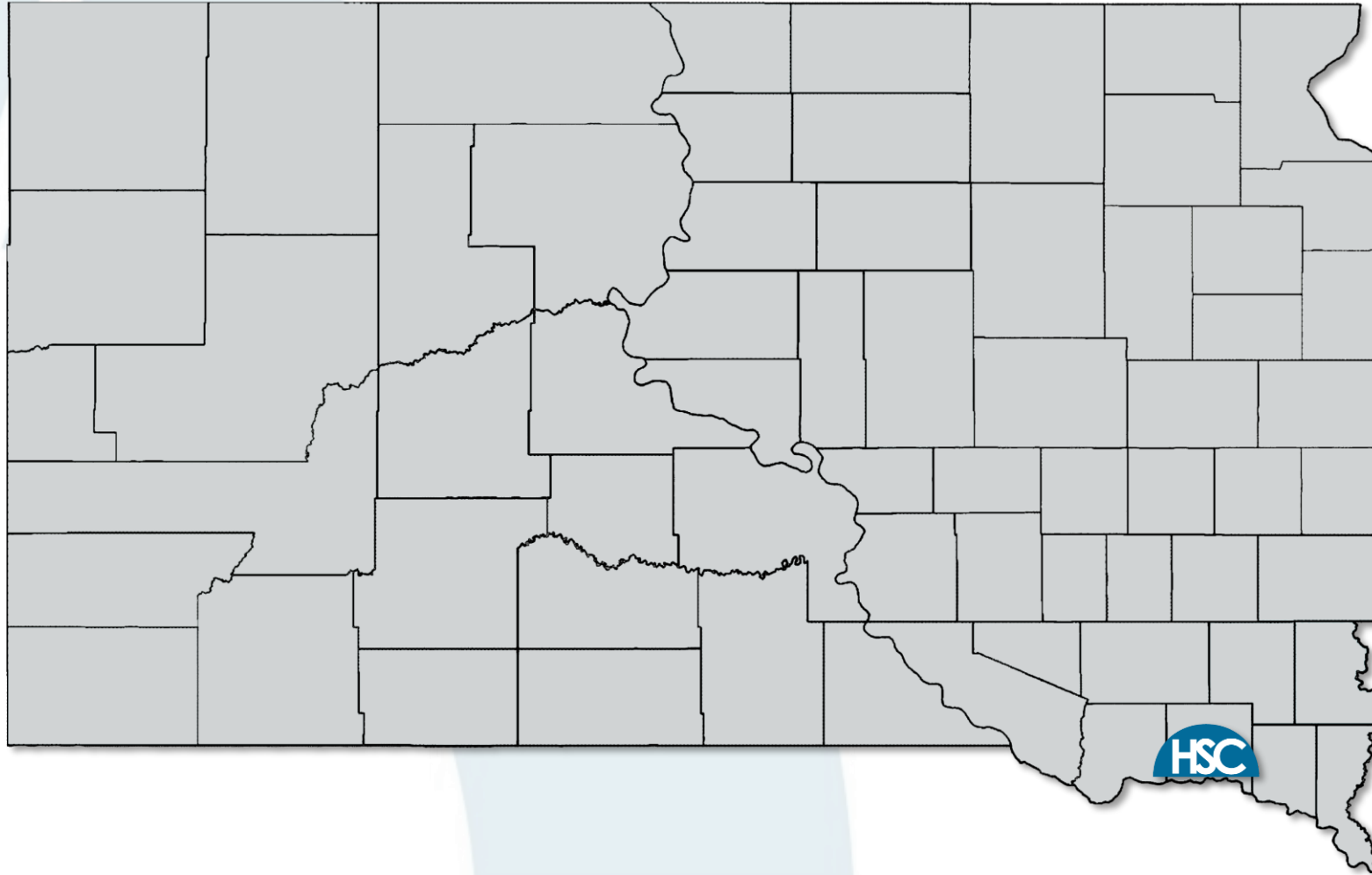

Referral to HSC

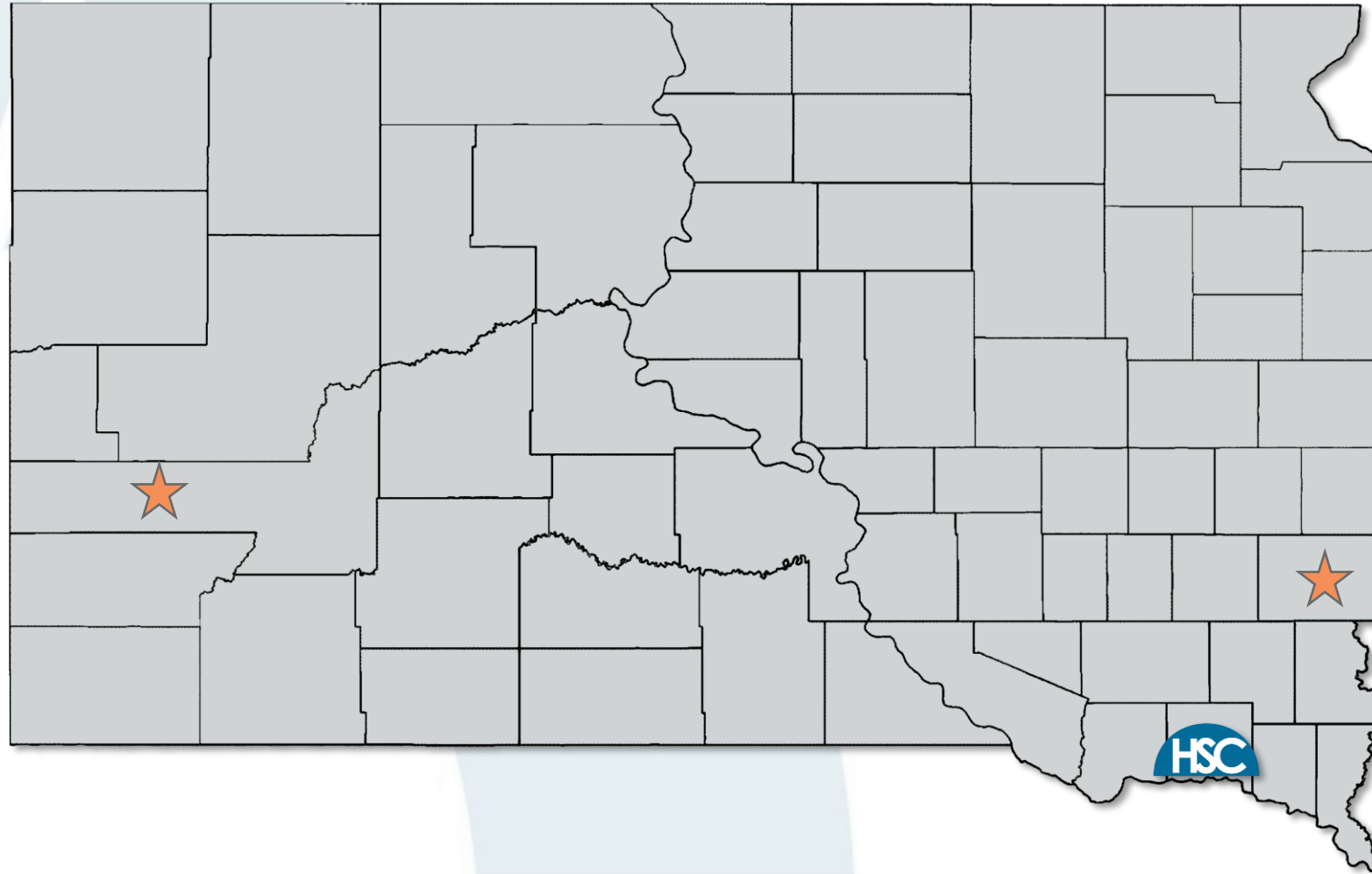
Assessment of defendant's ability and need

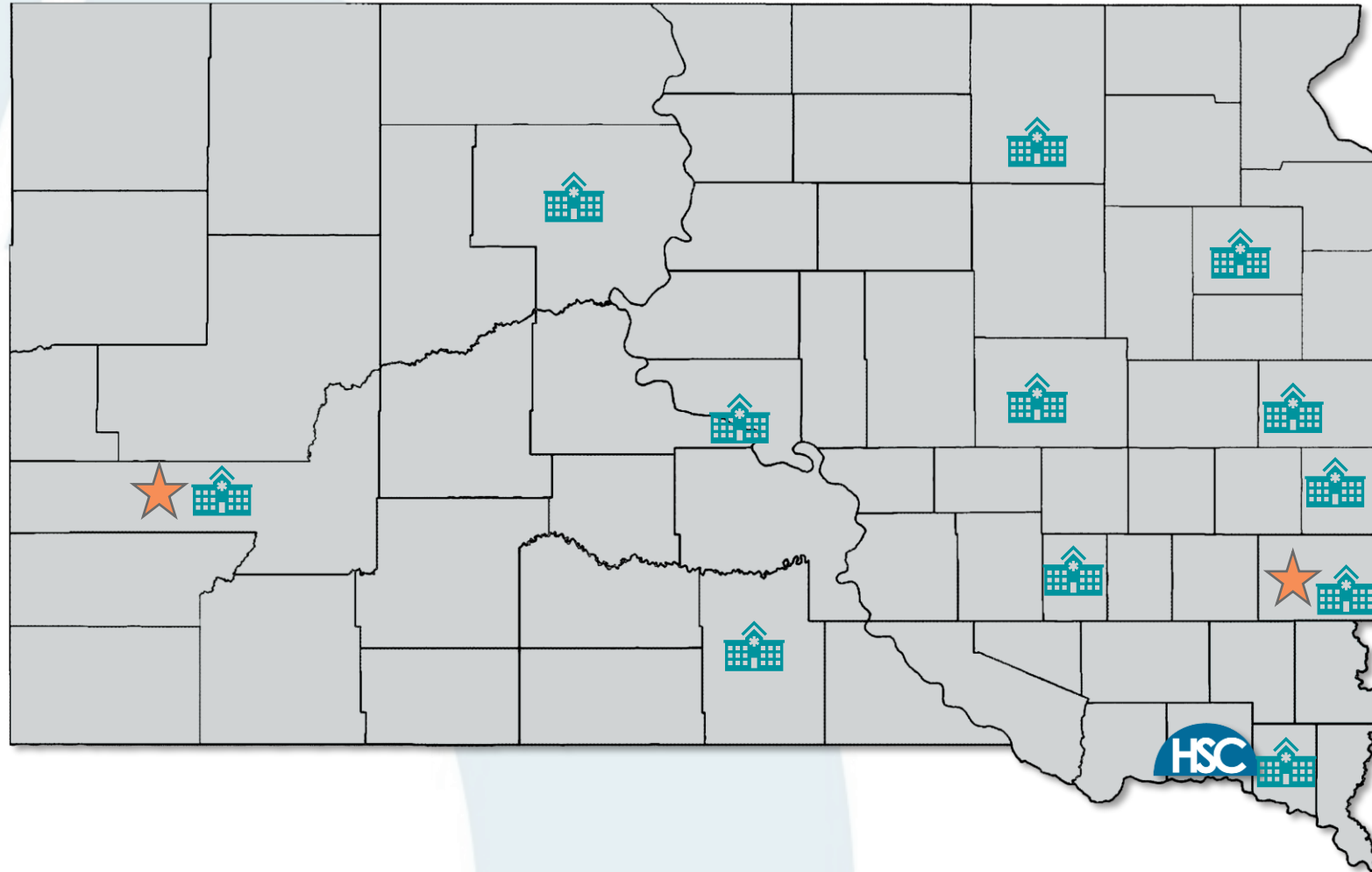

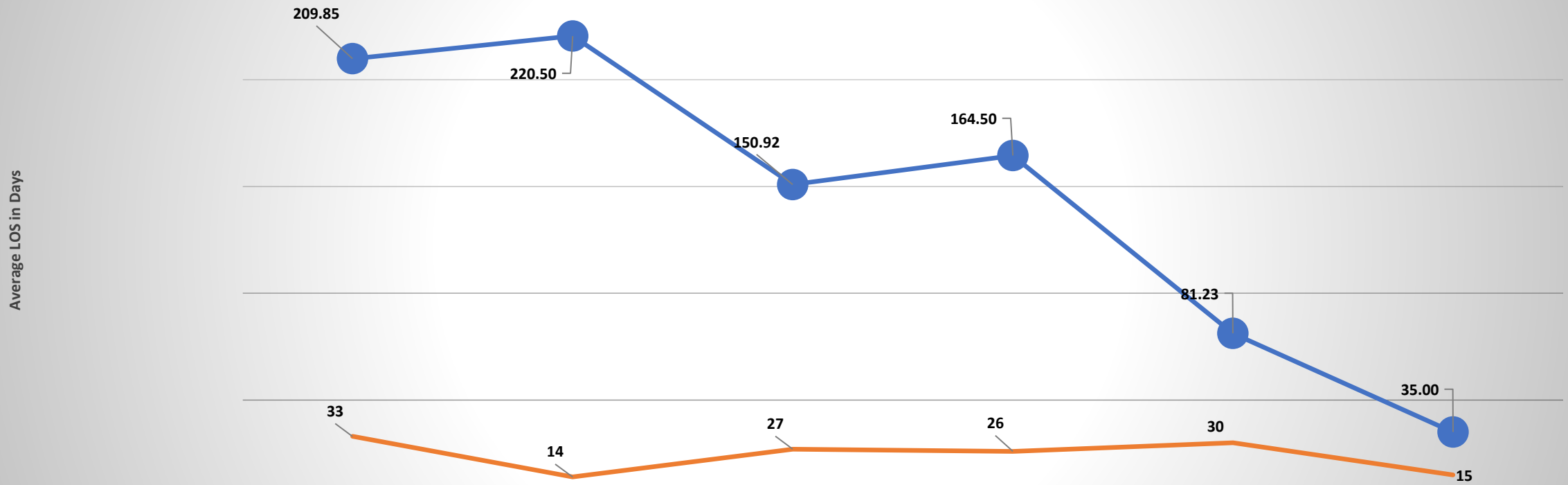

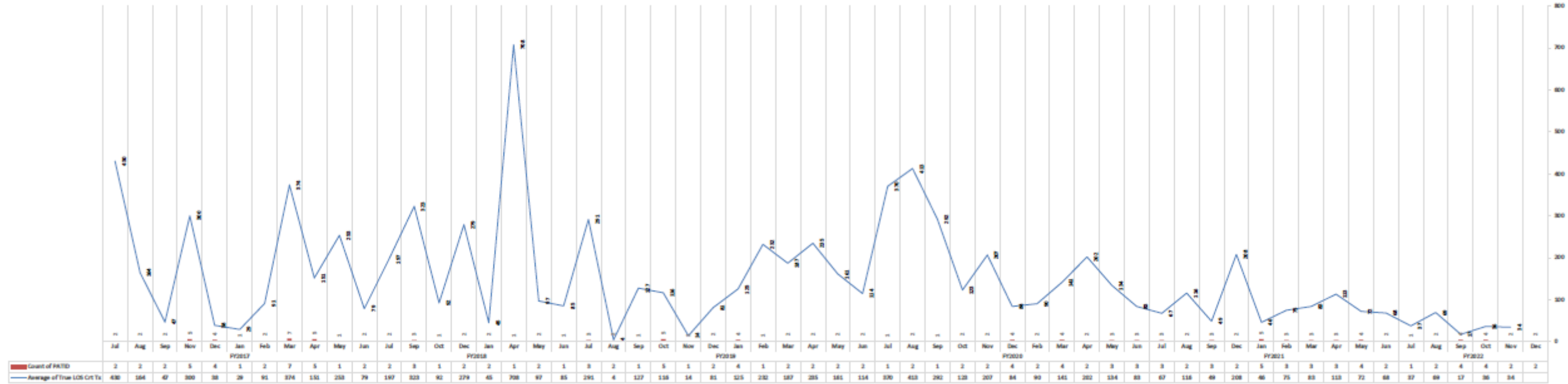
Average LOS for Adult Restoration Admissions at SDHSC
