Re: Open Meeting Laws Violation Complaint submitted by Todd B. Woods – October 1, 2019 Yankton County Commission Meeting

Dear Steve Blair, Counsel for the Open Meetings Commission,

I have reviewed the Open Meeting Laws Violation Complaint of the October 1, 2019 Yankton County Commission Meeting submitted by Todd B. Woods. Enclosed herein are the Complaint, the October 1, 2019 Yankton County Commission Meeting, Agenda, Meeting Minutes, and attachments presented at the Yankton County Commission Meeting. Upon review, I believe there may be merit for review before the Open Meetings Commission. The Complaint listed three reasons for review before the Open Meetings Commission, as detailed below.

 The Yankton County Commissioners added item #11A to approve Resolution YC 19-8, as an addition to the agenda.

SDCL 1-25-1.1 states that a public meeting must post its agenda at least twenty-four (24) hours before the commencement of the meeting. Resolution YC 19-8 was not listed in the posted agenda. While the motion to approve the agenda with the addition to approve Resolution 19-8 was carried, and Resolution YC 19-8 did not require any action or decision, it may constitute review before the Open Meetings Commission pursuant to SDCL 1-26-6(3) and 1-25-6.1.

2. Agenda item #12 to appoint an Acting Planning and Zoning Administrator, with the addition the Acting Planning and Zoning Administrator will act under the guidance of Commissioner Healy.

Agenda item #12 states "Appoint Acting Zoning Administrator."

Action 1945C in the Yankton County Commission minutes states: "A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Swensen to appoint Jessica Atkinson as acting Planning and Zoning Administrator under the Guidance of Commissioner Healy on Building Permits, Conditional Use and Variance applications and also to appoint the Planning and Zoning Commission to review any and all complaints that are received for zoning enforcement and render a decision on the complaints." The motion was carried.

The agenda did not prove that the Commission were to appoint a Commissioner of which would act in a supervisory role to the Planning and Zoning Administrator. Therefore, I believe the complaint may be submitted for review before the Open Meetings Commission pursuant to SDCL 1-26-6(3) and 1-25-6.1.

3. Agenda item #12 and the addition that all complaints received for zoning enforcement, and decisions made be reviewed and rendered by the Planning and Zoning Administrator.

Agenda item #12 states "Appoint Acting Zoning Administrator."

Action 1945C in the Yankton County Commission minutes states: "A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Swensen to appoint Jessica Atkinson as acting Planning and Zoning Administrator under the Guidance of Commissioner Healy on Building Permits, Conditional Use and Variance applications and also to appoint the Planning and Zoning Commission to review any and all complaints that are received for zoning enforcement and render a decision on the complaints." The motion was carried.

Agenda item #12 did not include the addition that "any and all complaints that are received for zoning enforcement and render a decision on the complaints," therefore, I believe the complaint may be submitted for review before the Open Meetings Commission pursuant to SDCL 1-25-6(3) and 1-25-6.1.

Dear Mr. Klimisch.

Under SDCL 1-25-6.1, let this serve as my notarized complaint of three open meeting law violations for the Yankton County Commission on October 1st, 2019.

First, the published agenda amended at the start of the meeting added item #11A resulting in the approval of Resolution YC 19-8. This was not part of the public packet or an item on the agenda.

Second, agenda item #12 titled "Appoint Acting Zoning Administrator" resulting in passing Action 19450C to appoint Jessica Atkinson as acting Planning and Zoning Administrator. The motion included Jessica would be under the guidance of Commissioner Healy. It also appointed the Yankton County Planning & Zoning Commission to review any and all complaints that are received for zoning enforcement and render a decision on the complaints. The addition of Commissioner Healy and the appointing the Planning & Zoning Commissioner as the enforcement arm of Yankton County were not publish agenda items or part of the packet available to the public.

Since the three matters I described above were not part of a published agenda or a part of the public packet 24 hours prior to the meeting this is a clear violation of open meeting laws. The resulting actions should be deemed invalid until the proper procedures are followed per South Dakota Codified Laws.

**CUP Public Hearing**: This was the time and place for a public hearing for a Conditional Use Permit application from Tim Binder. Applicant requested a permit to develop multi-family dwellings in the second-story of a Commercial District. Said property is legally described as S200' W330' Parcel A NE4, NW4 exc Lt H-2, S15-T93N-R56W, hereinafter referred to as Utica South Township, County of Yankton, State of South Dakota. The Planning Commission recommended approval.

Applicant Tim Binder spoke on his CUP request

Dear Commission:

The Yankton County Commission responds as hereinafter set forth to Ms. Srstka's letter dated July 10, 2020, addressing her review/investigation of Mr. Woods' Open Meeting Laws Violation Complaint of the October 1, 2019, Yankton County Commission Meeting. The Complaint listed three reasons for review.

1. WOODS' ALLEGED OPEN MEETING VIOLATION: The Yankton County Commissioners added item #11A to approve Resolution YC 19-8, as an addition to the agenda.

SRSTKA'S REVIEW: Ms. Srstka's review held that this alleged Open Meeting violation should be submitted to the Open Meeting Commission for review for the Yankton County Commission's failure to post it as an agenda item at least twenty-four hours in advance before the commencement of the meeting.

COUNTY'S RESPONSE TO NO. 1: Agenda #11A was for the "Emergency Mental Illness Board Appointment". As set forth in Resolution YC 19-8, this was for the appointment of the Yankton County Mental Illness Board to also serve as the mental health board for Lincoln County due to the destruction of their mental health facility. This agenda item had been noticed for approval for the September 18, 2019, Yankton County Commission meeting. See Exhibit 1, attached hereto denoted as No. 07 page 1 sixth line "Emergency Mental Illness Board Appointment". As the paperwork was not completed by the September 18, 2019, meeting the matter was continued. See Exhibit 2, attached hereto denoted as "Emergency Mental Illness Board Appointment: Item will be rescheduled for a later meeting" on page 4, lines 8 and 9.

The item was not only continued from the preceding meeting but also the Yankton County Commission's action was only the acceptance of an agreement between the Yankton County Mental Illness Board and the Lincoln County Mental Illness Board. Action and/or discussion by the Board was not required or necessary. See Exhibit 4 which contains the video of the continuance request from the previous meeting and the addition to the preliminary agenda prior to approval of the final agenda.

Items may be added or deleted from the preliminary agenda prior to the approval of the final agenda.

2. WOODS' ALLEGED OPEN MEETING VIOLATION: Agenda item #12 to appoint an Acting Planning and Zoning Administrator, with the addition the Acting Planning and Zoning Administrator will act under the guidance of Commissioner Healy.

SRSTKA'S REVIEW: Ms. Srstka's review held that this "agenda item did not prove that the Yankton County Commission were to appoint a Commissioner of which would act in a supervisory role to the Planning and Zoning Administrator" and therefore should be submitted to the Open Meeting Commission for review.

COUNTY'S RESPONSE: The County's response is included in

response No. 3 as hereinafter set forth.

3. WOODS' ALLEGED OPEN MEETING VIOLATION: Agenda item #12 and the addition that all complaints received for zoning enforcement, and decisions made be reviewed and rendered by the Planning and Zoning administrator.

SRSTKA'S REVIEW: Ms. Srstka's review held agenda item #12 did not include the addition that "any and all complaints that are received for zoning enforcement and render a decision on the complaints" for the Yankton County Commission to appointment the Planning and Zoning Commission to perform such tasks.

COUNTY'S RESPONSE TO NO. 2 & NO. 3: This agenda item was contained on the October 1, 2019, Agenda as No. 12 set for 6:40 pm entitled "Appoint Acting Zoning Administrator". See Exhibit 3, attached hereto denoted on line 1, page 2. Although the Complaint addresses these as separate violations, there was a single motion on Agenda item #12 which stated: "A motion was made by Loest and seconded by Swensen to appoint Jessica Atkinson as acting Planning and Zoning Administrator under the Guidance of Commissioner Healy Building Permits, Conditional Use and Variance applications and also to appoint the Planning and Zoning Commission to review any and all complaints that are received for zoning enforcement and render a decision on the complaints."

A reasonable prudent person could conclude that an Agenda item stating "Appoint Acting Zoning Administrator" would involve the delegation of the duties of a administrator to one or more persons. In this matter, the Yankton County Commission delegated duties of the zoning administrator position to Jessica Atkins for the performance of day-to-day routine matters, appointed Joseph Healy to review and assist in day-to-day routine matters and more complex zoning issues; and, appointed the Planning and Zoning Commission to assist in zoning enforcement and review. See Exhibit 4, attached hereto, which contains video of the discussion that occurred at the meeting regarding this agenda item and Exhibit 5 which is the Yankton Count Zoning Administrator job description.

All appointments occurred within the agenda item "Appoint Acting Zoning Administrator" and any other interpretation would result in limiting a commission in its ability to act on agenda items unless every conceivable action was addressed in the heading (ie. agenda item "Appoint Acting Zoning

Administrator To Handle Day-To-Day Activities, Appoint a Person to Help the Acting Zoning Administrator with Non-Day-To-Day Activities; and, Appoint the Planning Commission to handle Non-Day-To-Day Activities That Involve Zoning Complaints and Render Decisions. Requiring agenda items to include such detail would be cumbersome and impossible to manage.

WHEREAS, Yankton County has evaluated all available resources needed to mitigate potential damage to critical infrastructure and ensure life safety for the residents of Yankton County and has found that all resources will be expended as early as September 18, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the total costs for repair and improvements are not yet fully known but estimated to be in excess to what local resources are able to provide; and,

WHEREAS, the resulting damage and destruction will endanger and threaten the health, safety, and welfare of the public and the financial stability of the local governing units and the utility companies and power cooperatives generally; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Yankton County Commissioners does hereby declare an emergency due to the flooding of the James River in Yankton County, South Dakota.


