

Note:

- Part B and C dollars to CILS must meet the Requirements in Sec. 364,365 & 366 that includes CILS cannot serve only a single disability group (Sec. 725(2) Rehab Act).
- SSA \$ are VR Reimbursement funds from the VR Program and can be used for IL Services the same as Part B funds (Sec. 361.63)
- VR Title I funds can be used for the SILC Board support (Sec. 361.35)
- The dollars in the SILC total do not include the costs for the VR Board support
- Ramp funds are dependent on amount of available funding from the DSE; these contract amounts are renegotiated annually; each CIL provides an estimate for ramps they believe they can complete in 1 years' time.
