PURPOSE OF REPORT

The purpose of this report is to provide an estimated total cost of attendance by program and by award level at each technical college.

Three types of costs are included in this report:

- 1. Tuition
- 2. State Fees
- 3. Local Fees

The South Dakota Board of Technical Education approves tuition and state fee rates. Tuition and state fee rates are the same across all four technical colleges.

In addition to tuition and state fees, students will also pay local fees. Local fees, unlike tuition and state fees, are approved by local governing boards.

METHODOLOGY

The estimated costs reflected in this report are based on a student:

- 1. Enrolling full-time.
- 2. Following the exact sequence of a student's program of study and completing the minimum number of credits.
- 3. Satisfactory completion of all credits.

Additionally, estimated costs are based on the minimum cost of attendance.

LIMITATIONS

- 1. The number of credits enrolled and completed by semester will affect overall cost of attendance. Various local fees are assessed on a persemester basis. For example, students enrolling part-time will experience higher costs due to enrolling in additional semesters.
- 2. Tuition, state fee, and local fee amounts are held constant based on the respective fiscal year. For example, an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree typically takes two academic years to complete. Any changes to costs from Year 1 to Year 2 are not factored.
- 3. Living expenses (housing, meals, transportation, childcare, etc.) are not reflected in this report. These expenses can be, and often are, a substantial component of a student's experience.
- 4. The estimated costs in this report are based on the minimum cost of attendance. For example, if a program is offered through multiple delivery types (In-Person; Online; Blended), and an institution assesses an additional "Online/Blended Fee," the delivery type with the lowest cost is used.
- 5. The estimated costs in this report are not guaranteed and are based on calculations. Prospective and current students should reach out to institutional financial aid offices for additional, accurate, and adjusted cost information.
