CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Glenn Blumhardt. The roll was called, and a quorum was present.

The meeting was streaming live on SD.net, a service of South Dakota Public Broadcasting.

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Glenn Blumhardt, Bob Ewing, Jessica Gruenwald, Tim Johns, Doyle Karpen, Rhett Miller, Bob Morris, Bruce Outka, and Laurie Schultz.

BOARD MEMBERS ABSENT: None.

APPROVE AGENDA: Motion by Karpen, seconded by Schultz, to approve the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM JUNE 18, 2026, MEETING: Motion by Ewing, seconded by Morris, to approve the minutes from the June 18, 2026, Board of Minerals and Environment meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

MINING ISSUES CONSENT CALENDAR: Prior to the meeting the board received a copy of the consent calendar (see attachment).

Tom Cline, Minerals, Mining, and Superfund Program, was available for questions from the board. There were no questions.

Motion by Outka, seconded by Schultz, to approve the consent calendar, as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

POWERTECH (USA) INC. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF SOCIOECONOMIC CONTRACTOR FOR PROPOSED LARGE-SCALE MINE PERMIT APPLICATION: Eric Holm reported that Powertech (USA), Inc. has requested board approval of Western Water Consultants, Inc. dba WWC Engineering (WWC) as its socioeconomic contractor. Powertech (USA), Inc. is applying for a large-scale mine permit for a proposed uranium in-situ recovery mining operation.

Under the mining statutes, an applicant for a large-scale mine is required to do a socioeconomic impact study and include it in its mine permit application. The law requires the applicant to get approval from the Board of Minerals and Environment for the contractor to conduct the study.

As part of its decision-making process on a mine permit application, the board has authority to consider the socioeconomic impacts of a mining operation. The board has authority to deny a mine permit application if it finds the adverse socioeconomic impacts of the proposed mining operation outweigh the benefits of the operation.

A copy of WWC's Statement of Qualifications was included in the packet that was sent to the board prior to the meeting.

Jay Douthit with Powertech was present and Doyle Fritz and Jack Fritz with WWC were available on-line to answer questions.

The original socioeconomic study was updated in 2012-2013 by Doyle Fritz, WWC. In 2024, WWC prepared a combined Technical Report and Environmental Report, including socioeconomic analysis, for a Nuclear Regulatory Commission license renewal application for this project. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission approved the renewal and issued a 20-year license on June 30, 2026,

Motion by Johns, seconded by Ewing, to approve WWC Engineering as the socioeconomic contractor for Powertech (USA), Inc.'s large-scale mine permit application. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion carried unanimously.
