- 2018 Systems of Care (SOC) began

Access to Treatment Services

To Address the Needs of Justice-Involved Youth and Families

- Referrals for Assessment by Clinician
- Core Services
 - FFT, MRT, ART, SUD treatment, plus SOC for at-risk youth
- Additional EBPs Available to Meet the Needs Examples:
 - Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT)
 - Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR)
 - Brief Strategic Family Therapy (BSFT)
 - Accelerated Resolution Therapy (ART)
 - Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT)
 - Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT)
 - Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT)
