SUBJECT: Davison County Regional Railroad Authority Loan Amendment Request

The Davison County Regional Railroad Authority (RRA) currently holds a \$12.6 million loan from the South Dakota Railroad Board at a 2.0% interest rate, amortized over fifteen years with a balloon payment due after seven years.

The RRA is now requesting to amend the approved loan terms by increasing the total loan amount from \$12.6 million to \$18,310,700 while maintaining the 2.0% interest rate, fifteen-year amortization schedule, and seven-year balloon payment structure.

High Plains Processing (HPP) currently has an outstanding loan balance of \$12.6 million. Eligible project costs total \$18,310,700, resulting in an additional loan request of \$5,710,700 to cover the remaining eligible expenses associated with the project.

SECTION II. PROJECT INFORMATION

Description of Project (attach plans/drawings and cost budget) As part of this project, a total of 33,159 track-ft of new rail, 22 new industrial turnouts and 2 new BNSF Mainline turnouts. See attached page for preliminary layout from Civil Design Inc. Current traffic estimates are: 147 rail cars and 3-5 switches per week. Manifest trains will range from 30-60 cars. Unit trains of 100 cars will ship 1-2 times per month. Fleet size is estimated at 450 hoppers, 265 tanks.

Description of Economic Benefits of the Project During and After Construction High Plains Processing (HPP) is developing a multi-seed, switch-processing facility that is capable of processing 35M bushels of soybeans annually, equivalent to 1M tons of high-oil content seed crops. The facility is projected to produce approximately 570,000 tons of seed meal and 300,000 tons of oil annually after Year 4. Planned storage volume is as follows: 4M bushels of soybeans/high oil content seeds, 8,000 MT of meal/hulls, 12.3M gallons of crude oil, and 3.52M gallons of refined oil. Employment projections are estimated at 85 FTEs with approximately \$5.5M+/- in annual salaries. This project will also have an extremely large impact on local sales tax due to the spike in construction and long term employment

Explain the Transportation Needs of the Area Served by the Project: High Plains Processing has worked and is working closely with the SDDOT and the County High Superintendent on improving Highway 37 to include ~1,000 feet of turn lane extensions on both the northbound and southbound land. Additionally, HPP is required per the traffic impact study that was performed to widen and lengthen the turn land on 257th (landfill road) that is in the county's jurisdiction to allow safe truck flow in and out of the plant.

Explain: HPP has successfully went through the Davison County Local Permitting process (conditional use permit) in July of 2022. HPP is currently in the process of obtaining all necessary state permits via DANR and has frequent communication with their office to ensure these permits are done correctly and streamlined.

High Plains Processing has also been diligently working with DANR on the Air Permit (obtained but sent back in for an amendment), Wastewater Permit (ready to submit), Above Ground Storage Tank Permit (ready to submit), and Stormwater Permit.
