Challenges and successes

- The project was re-designed to fit within the existing ROW, eliminating need to purchase extra ROW.
- Complete environmental processes are required due to construction on undisturbed ground even though it is next to the existing mainline.
- The original estimate was low plus inflation added to the cost. Extra federal funding was approved, keeping under 80%.
- The funding agreements were executed June 10, 2025
- Final design is in review.
- Excavation is planned for Fall 2025, track construction in 2026.



CRISI 2022 SISSETON MILBANK MODERNIZATION PROJECT UPDATE



Challenges and successes

- The project will rebuild 37 miles of 100 year old 60 to 90 pound jointed rail, replace turnouts and crossings, and repair and strengthen bridges. The rebuilt line will handle 286,000 lb. rail cars at 25 MPH.
- Environmental Clearance and Preliminary Engineering were completed April 2025.
- Funding contracts have been drafted but recent flood damage needs to be assessed before final execution.



RAISE 2021 RCPE SOUTH DAKOTA EXPANSION PROJECT UPDATE



Challenges and successes

- The project will upgrade 87.7 miles of jointed rail with heavier, continuous welded rail, upgrade 121 Timber bridge structures, 9 steel/concrete bridge structures, 80,000 mainline cross ties, 11 mainline turnouts, 122 private and public crossings, and install 76,200 tons of ballast and 4 new multipurpose hot wheel, hot bearing and dragging detectors to permit 286,000lb cars and increase speed to a minimum of 25 mph between Fort Pierre and Rapid City, South Dakota. Completion of the project will be in 2026.
- The rail construction was awarded to RJ Corman with a completion date of November 1, 2026.
- Timber bridge strengthening was awarded to Continental with a completion date of August 1, 2026.
- The bid opening for the wayside detectors and steel/concrete bridge construction should be next month.

Challenges and successes


- Funding agreements were executed November 25, 2024.
- Excavation is nearly complete except for installing the mechanic pit.
- Track construction in expected to begin in fall 2025.

STC 2021 RCPE INCREASING RAIL RESILIENCY PROJECT UPDATE


Challenges and Successes

FEDERAL \$ 878,892 LOCAL MATCH \$ 219,723 TOTAL FUNDING \$1,098,615

- Once a hydrology study was completed it was apparent the scope of the project would need to be revised. Originally, the scope was to replace or install culverts at 7 locations and remove and fill in 22 spans of a 25-span bridge. The revised scope is to replace and install culverts at 5 locations and strengthen the 25-span bridge.
- Preliminary design and environmental were approved by FRA in June 2025.
- A funding agreement should be signed this month, then the final design will be completed and submitted to FRA for approval.
- · Construction is planned for 2026.
