SUBJECT: Black Hills Fly-in Funding Request

The City of Spearfish requests the Commission's consideration of \$1,000 in support for the 2025 Black Hills Fly-In, held on September 11–14, 2025 at the Spearfish Airport (SPF). This annual event attracts aviators from across South Dakota and neighboring states, offering a unique opportunity to showcase the beauty of the Black Hills region and to promote general aviation to the public. The Fly-In has grown each year, welcoming more than 75 aircraft in 2024, with organizers anticipating an even larger turnout in 2025. The Fly-In will feature a variety of activities designed to engage both pilots and the public, including:

- Daily Fly-Outs to regional airports
- Saturday, September 13 Events:
 - 150+ Car Show
 - o STOL (Short Takeoff and Landing) Demonstration
 - Aerobatic Demonstration
 - Concert and Food Trucks
 - Airplane Rides for the public

This event provides valuable exposure for aviation, encourages tourism, and strengthens community connections to local airports. The Commission has a history of supporting aviation outreach events, such as Mitchell Airport's Air Venture Race. The City of Spearfish believes the Black Hills Fly-In delivers similar statewide benefits by promoting aviation education, community engagement, and pilot participation.
