

SOUTH DAKOTA BOARD OF EDUCATION STANDARDS
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS

A public hearing will be held at the Sioux Falls Convention Center, 1201 N West Avenue, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time, November 21, 2022, to consider the adoption and implementation of the following: career and technical education academic content standards, and social studies academic content standards. This is the second of four public hearings regarding these standards.

Career and Technical Education (CTE) Academic Content Standards:

Business Management and Administration Career Cluster: The goal of the Business Management and Administration Career Cluster standards is to support students in the planning, organizing, directing, and evaluating business functions essential to efficient and productive business operations.

Capstone Experiences: The Capstone Experiences course standards allow students the opportunity to consolidate and apply the learning from their high school coursework into a meaningful and relevant career-related experience that is student-driven and based on a student's chosen career cluster or pathway.

Hospitality and Tourism Career Cluster: The goal of the Hospitality and Tourism Career Cluster standards is to support students in the management, marketing, and operations of restaurants and other foodservices, lodging, tourism, recreational events, and travel-related services.

Marketing Career Cluster: The goal of the Marketing Career Cluster standards is to support students in planning, managing, and performing marketing activities to reach organizational objectives.

Transportation, Distribution, and Logistics Career Cluster: The goal of the Transportation, Distribution, and Logistics Career Cluster standards is to support students in the planning, management, and movement of people, materials, and goods by road, pipeline, air, rail, and water and related professional and technical support services.

Social Studies Academic Content Standards : The goal of social studies standards is to support students in learning social studies skills, and content to include history, geography, civics, and economics.
