Description: Ancestral remains of Individual 1, plus associated funerary objects, from burial feature and fragmentary ancestral remains of Individuals 2, 3, and 4, plus associated funerary objects, from a disturbed slump context. Recovered from private land per the State Burial Laws in consultation with the Three Affiliated Tribes (see Burial Report 2025-26).

Reason: Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act (NAGPRA). Public Law 101-601- November 16, 1990. Section 7, Repatriation. The ARC is in the process of submitting the applicable Notice of Inventory Completion for its publication in the *Federal Register*. The ARC will generate an Outgoing Transfer form to document the repatriation process following the 30-day comment period provided in the *Federal Register* publication; Dustin Lloyd, ARC Burial Program Coordinator, will coordinate the transfer of the deaccessioned ancestral remains and associated funerary objects directly to representatives of the Three Affiliated Tribes, who have been determined as culturally affiliated with the burial.
