Chairman Mike Vehle called the meeting of the South Dakota Transportation Commission (the "Commission") to order at 9:00 a.m. CST

Roll call was taken, and a quorum was determined.

Vehle opened the floor to the Commission members to disclose potential conflicts of interest and to present requests for waiver pursuant of South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) chapter 3 - 23.

No conflicts were disclosed, and no waivers were requested.

Vehle asked for a motion to approve the November 24, 2020, Commission meeting minutes.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Cull and seconded by Roby to approve the November 24, 2020, Commission meeting minutes. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Interim Secretary Joel Jundt presented the following items for the Secretary's Report:

- 1. The current federal funding authorization was previously extended by Congress through a continuing resolution which is now set to expire December 18, 2020. Congress is still in discussions and negotiations regarding future federal funding.
- 2. Veteran's Parkway section is now open as of Tuesday, December 15 from I-90 to 57th Street. Commissioner Rosenboom asked about 26th Street in Sioux Falls and its status. Craig Smith, Director of the Division of Operations shared with the Commission that 26th Street has been opened. Work is still being done in the area as weather permits but all lanes are open.
- 3. South Dakota Highway 262 (SD262) was closed between Alexandria and Emery in 2019 due to flooding. This section of highway has been reopened and is in use. Emergency Relief funds were used to pay a portion of the costs for this project.
- 4. The temporary bridge near Salem on South Dakota Highway 38 (SD38) which was closed due to being hit by an over-width vehicle has been reopened. The Department of Transportation (the "Department") is working to get the permanent bridge project let by next summer so construction can begin in 2022.
- 5. Governor Noem's Budget Address recommends similar funding as last year for the Department. The Governor recommended in her budget \$5 million for the purchase of a new state aircraft and is asking the Department to sell two of its older aircraft.
- 6. The Department in continuing to review and monitor the speed zone change on South Dakota Highway 212 (SD212) in LaPlant. LaPlant and the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe have submitted a Transportation Alternatives (TA) grant application for additional funding to assist with pedestrian traffic safety in this area. The TA applications will be brought to the Commission at the January meeting. The TA program is administered by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to help states fund a variety of activities related to improving transportation assets, including on-and off-road pedestrian and bicycle facilities, environmental mitigation, and creating or improving recreational trails projects. Christina Bennett, Department Traffic Engineer, indicated the speed limit change took effect on November 30, and new speed limit signs were installed that day along with pedestrian warning signs. The Department is not aware of any issues since the installation of the new speed zone signs and pedestrian warning signs.
- 7. The current Leadership Development Program members were in attendance and will have a graduation celebration today after completing the 14-month training program. This group of members is the first group to participate in the program, whose purpose is to broaden leadership skills personally and expand upon team leadership skills within the Department across the state. The program began in September 2019. The Department hopes to start the next group once inperson contact can be safely accommodated.

Craig Smith, Division of Operations Director, presented the following Construction Change Orders (CCOs) to the Commission from October.

Over the past 12 months, the overall contract increase is 1.82%.

This variation in quantity is common for this work due to the opportunity for the Department to make a more comprehensive inspection of the pavement once traffic is removed.

The additional quantity of detector loops was due to a plan error. The additional quantity of woven separator fabric was added to help stabilize a portion of the grade. The additional reinforced concrete pipe culverts were due to a change in the roadway section from a rural section to an urban section after the project was let.

The Department added a temporary traffic signal system at the request of the City of Sioux Falls to safely control traffic at the Cliff Avenue and 85th Street intersection. The Department adjusted the contract quantity of unclassified excavation to match the quantity performed during construction due to additional excavation necessary resulting from unstable spots in the new grade.

The variation for groove rumble strip was made to correct a plan error. The variations for asphalt for flush seal and pavement marking paint resulted from eliminating a portion of the work due to conflicts with adjacent projects.

Smith then presented to the Commission the CCOs from November.

Over the past 12 months, the overall contract increase is 2.33%.
