Chairman Karim called the meeting of the South Dakota Transportation Commission (the "Commission") to order at 9:00 a.m. CDT. A roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

Karim opened the floor to the Commission members to disclose potential conflicts of interest and to present requests for waiver pursuant to South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) chapters 3-23.

Commissioner Simons indicated a potential conflict of interest with bid award items \#3B - 6 and \#3B - 8 as his company may perform work for the contractor bidding on the project and a potential conflict of interest with right of way items \#2 and \#3 because his company may purchase land in this area. He stated he will recuse himself from participation and vote on these items.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Vehle and seconded by Jensen that the matters disclosed verbally by Commissioner Simons are fair, reasonable, and not contrary to public interest. All present voted aye by roll call vote except Simons who abstained. The motion carried.

Karim asked for any other potential conflicts of interest. No other members of the Commission disclosed a conflict or requested a waiver.

Karim asked for a motion to approve the November 21, 2023 Commission meeting minutes.
A MOTION WAS MADE by Roby and seconded by Zander to approve the November 21, 2023 Commission meeting minutes. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Karim opened the floor to public input.
No members of the public addressed the Commission nor offered input.

Secretary Joel Jundt presented the following items in his Secretary's Report to the Commission:

- The Federal appropriations bill was not passed by 11/17/2023 but another continuing resolution was passed and is set to expire 01/19/2024.
- The Department of Transportation (the "Department") was awarded a $\$ 67$ million Rural Surface Transportation Grant for the project on US385 from Sheridan Lake to the Pennington/Lawrence County line. This will supplement the total cost of this project. Currently, the Department is waiting to hear about the federal MEGA grant and INFRA grant awards, which the Department submitted grant applications in for the Platte-Winner bridge project and the South Veterans Parkway corridor.
- State legislature begins on January 9, 2024. The Department is involved in one bill that would make electronic remote notarization available. If passed, the process for getting contracts signed could be significantly streamlined.
- Vehicle Miles Travelled (VMT) Advisory Team had its kick-off meeting in December and Commissioners Simons and Vehle participated in the meeting. The next step is to invite Utah DOT to an information exchange so the Team can learn from their experience in establishing a program. Jundt noted that the VMT program would be an alternative to the gas tax, not in addition to the gas tax.
- Two more bridge hits occurred recently. One in Sioux Falls at I-29 and $12^{\text {th }}$ Street. There was damage to the girders and the Department is working with the tortfeasor's insurance for reimbursement for damages. The second hit was south of Watertown at I-29 and $458^{\text {th }}$ Street, also involving girder damage. These projects will use State construction funds and be added to the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
- Mark Hoines of the Federal Highway Administration passed away suddenly on December 18, 2023. His celebration of life will take place in January 2024. Mark will be missed by his many friends and colleagues at the Department.
- In January, election of officers will be on the agenda.
- Craig Smith, Division of Operations Director, shared with the Commission a summary of major construction projects and projected completion dates for carryover projects. He also noted that
a group is working with South Dakota Association of General Contractors (AGC) to review the current process for setting completion dates on construction projects.
- Lastly, Jundt reported that the Department is required by statute to present the legislative Transportation Committees an annual assets status update. The plan is to present to the Committees on January 11 and January 12, 2024. He also noted that the Department will be before the Committee on Joint Appropriations in February for their budget hearing.

Craig Smith, Division Director of Operations, presented the following informational Construction Change Orders (CCO) to the Commission.

CCOs completed in November contain an increase of $\$ 1,189,879.75$. Over the past 12 months, the overall contract increase is $2.61 \%$.
