Vice-chair Robert Huggins called the meeting of the South Dakota Aeronautics Commission (the “Commission”) to order at 2:02 p.m. CDT. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was determined.

Huggins opened the floor to the Commission to disclose potential conflicts of interest and to present requests for waiver pursuant to the South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) Chapter 3-23.

No conflicts of interest were disclosed, and no waivers were requested.

Huggins asked for a motion to approve the May 20, 2021 Commission meeting minutes.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Rieber and seconded by Nelson to approve the May 20, 2021 Commission meeting minutes. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Discussion regarding aircraft registration laws was deferred to a latter meeting.

Huggins opened the floor to public input. No members of the public addressed the Commission or offered input.

Secretary Joel Jundt presented the Secretary’s Report. Jundt shared that no decisions have been made by the U.S. Congress regarding the Federal Reauthorization and Appropriation bills that would give a definitive amount of funding the Commission could expect moving forward.

Jon Becker, Office of Air, Rail, and Transit, presented to the Commission sixteen (16) 2021 Airport Improvement Program (AIP) applications as described in Attachment #2 with two corrections – Hot Springs and Hoven. All but one AIP projects will be paid 100% from federal funding.
