Vice Chairman Austin Simons called the meeting of the South Dakota Transportation Commission (the "Commission") to order at 9:00 a.m. CT. A roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

Chairman Roby joined the meeting at 9:01 a.m. Roby opened the floor to the Commission members to disclose potential conflicts of interest and to present requests for waiver pursuant to South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) chapters 3-23.

Commissioner Austin Simons disclosed a potential conflict of interest on Item #7 of Attachment #5 which involves a potential conflict that was previously disclosed and waived. He stated he will recuse himself from the discussion and vote on Item #7 of Attachment #5.

No other members of the Commission disclosed a conflict or requested a waiver.

Roby asked for a motion to approve the May 15, 2025 Commission meeting minutes.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Rosenboom and seconded by Karim to approve the May 15, 2025 Commission meeting minutes. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Karla Engle, Office of Legal Counsel, announced a public hearing on the Commission's consideration of the proposed amendments to Administrative Rules of South Dakota (ARSD) 70:01:02:36 - Hughes County speed zone rule, ARSD 70:01:02:58, Stanley County speed zone rule, and ARSD 70:03:01:65 Longer combination vehicle -- approved routes and access restrictions. These rules would be adopted under the general authority of SDCL 32-25-7; 32-25-7.1; 32-22-42; and 32-22-42.14.

Engle explained the rule adoption process that had been followed to date for the amendments to the rules. She discussed the purpose and effect of the rule changes. Engle reported that no written comments on the rule changes had been timely received. Engle stated that changes required by Legislative Research Council were incorporated into the proposed rules.

Roby asked for public testimony in favor of or opposed to the proposed rule amendments. No members of the public offered testimony in support of or in opposition to the rule changes.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Jensen and seconded by Vallery to approve the proposed amendments to ARSD 70:01:02:36 - Hughes County speed zone rule, ARSD 70:01:02:58, Stanley County speed zone rule, and ARSD 70:03:01:65 Longer combination vehicle -- approved routes and access restrictions. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

RESOLUTION #2025 – 5.1 was adopted.

Engle then requested the Commission set a hearing date of June 26, 2025 to consider amendments to ARSD 70:01:02:03 – Brown County speed zone rules.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Vehle and seconded by Rosenboom to set the administrative hearing date of June 26, 2025, for consideration of amendments to ARSD 70:01:02:03 – Brown County speed zone rules. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

RESOLUTION #2025 – 5.2 was adopted.

Roby opened the floor to public input.

No members of the public addressed the Commission or offered any input.

Secretary Joel Jundt presented the following items to the Commission in his Secretary's Report:

- Federal: The House passed their budget reconciliation bill on May 22, 205 that will significantly change spending across various sectors. From a surface transportation aspect, the bill appears to be favorable towards highway and bridge infrastructure with minimal impact on the current amount of funding, but we are still needing to go through the bill language to determine exact impact. Within the bill is an annual \$250 flat fee on electric vehicles and \$100 on hybrids. This additional revenue is projected to increase revenue by \$64 billion over the 2025-2034 period. States would be required to collect the registration fee.
- Emergency Relief (ER) Funding: We were notified by Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) that ER funding for the event that occurred on June 16, 2024 in the southeast part of the state is now available to the State and local governments. Therefore, we will be finalizing necessary documentation and getting those reimbursement requests submitted to FHWA. The amount of funding is \$24,038,590. This includes both state and local amounts determined eligible last year. Reimbursement will be according to actual prices and these are based on 1.) work already complete and 2.) for work that still needs to be let and performed by a contractor.
- Access Permit. The Town of Isabel sent a letter of support for a business (Western Dakota Bank) and requested the Commission's support for the access permit that will serve the business. The Department will review the request for access in accordance with its procedures.

Craig Smith, Division Director of Operations, presented the following informational Construction Change Orders (CCO) to the Commission.

CCOs completed in April contain a decrease of \$648,783.18. Over the past 12 months, the overall contract increase is 1.67%.

The material on site was too silty to produce stable slopes.

<u>Explanation of Change on CCO No. 5:</u> This increase is the result of SDDOT adjusting the contract quantities to match as built quantities, an incentive payment for pavement smoothness, and extra work including extra concrete pavement needed at the end of a bridge, erosion control, and additional asphalt and concrete removal not specified in the plans. The incentive payment was made in accordance with the contract.

<u>Explanation of Change on CCO No. 5:</u> This increase is the result of SDDOT adding extra work to the contract by adding a 4 ft curb and gutter section on Ramp G and adding longitudinal tied joints to Ramps A, B, C, and D. This work will reduce the width of the ramp lane to add 4 ft of shoulder and prevent longitudinal cracking on the ramp.

<u>Explanation of Change on CCO No. 12:</u> This increase is the result of SDDOT compensating the contractor for extra work to haul waste material to a suitable site. The additional waste material was due to a lower shrinkage factor of the embankment material than estimated in the plans.

<u>Explanation of Change on CCO No. 2:</u> This increase is the result of SDDOT adjusting the contract quantities to match as built quantities. The variation in quantities is considered normal for a signing and delineation job.

<u>Explanation of Change on CCO No. 4:</u> This decrease is the result of SDDOT removing certain items from the contract as well as adjusting contract quantities to match as built quantities.

<u>Explanation of Change on CCO No. 5:</u> This decrease is the result of SDDOT adjusting contract quantities to match as built quantities and minor quality adjustments for out of specification material.
