Chairman Lynn Jensen called the meeting of the South Dakota Transportation Commission (the "Commission") to order at 9:00 a.m. CT. A roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

Jensen opened the floor to the Commission members to disclose potential conflicts of interest and to present requests for waiver pursuant to South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) chapters 3 – 23.

No members of the Commission disclosed a conflict or requested a waiver.

Jensen asked for a motion to approve the September 23 - 24, 2024 Commission meeting minutes.

Commissioner Vehle asked that a sentence in the public input section from Jodie Remington be made clearer. Karla Engle, Legal Office, suggested "...that seems to her *to* create an unfair burden *for* her..." which added the words "to" and "for."

A MOTION WAS MADE by Rosenboom and seconded by Valley to approve the September 23-24, 2024 Commission meeting minutes with the suggested edits. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Jensen asked for a motion to approve the October 10, 2024 Commission meeting minutes.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Frick and seconded by Vehle to approve the October 10, 2024 Commission meeting minutes. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Jensen opened the floor to public input.

Gerrit Juffer of Wagner addressed the Commission. He thanked the Department of Transportation (the "Department") for the improvements west of Wagner on SD46. He also shared that there has not been a response to the Yankton Sioux Tribe resolution opposing the proposed three-lane reconstruction project of SD46 through Wagner and that it is damaging the relationship and asked for action on the resolution.

No other members of the public addressed the Commission or offered any input.

Secretary Joel Jundt presented the following items to the Commission in his Secretary's Report:

• Federal government has not passed a full year appropriations bill but did pass a continuing resolution that will expire on December 20, 2024. Projects will continue be let as usual with anticipation that Congress will eventually pass the needed appropriations legislation.

- The administrative rules that were adopted by the Commission at the September meeting have passed through Legislative Rules Review Committee and will take effect.
- Jundt updated the Commission regarding the spring flooding situation in the southeast corner of the state. It was noted that many of the sites were deemed eligible for Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Emergency Relief funds and that the Department will continue to use state highway funds via the emergency procurement processes until reimbursable federal funding is provided.
- The Department has a ribbon cutting at Benson Road in Sioux Falls on Friday, October 25 to celebrate the 3rd Diverging Diamond Intersection (DDI) in the state.

- October 30 is "Buckle Up/ Phones Down" Day and the Department has created a webpage where the public can learn about aligning safe driver behaviors as well as sign a pledge to make better choices.
- Jundt introduced the 4th cohort of the Leadership Development Program which was attending the meeting. He congratulated the Cohort and thanked them for the desire to enhance themselves and the Department.

Jundt presented for Commission consideration the proposed Commission meeting dates for CY2025.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Karim and seconded by Rosenboom to approve the CY2025 Commission meeting dates as proposed by the Department. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Craig Smith, Division Director of Operations, presented the following informational Construction Change Orders (CCO) to the Commission.

CCOs completed in September contain an increase of \$162,427.56. Over the past 12 months, the overall contract increase is 2.11%.

The main recommendation from the survey was further education of the services offered.


