Cuka	Daniel M.	SSG	OEF/OIF	(SD Army NG) Killed December 4, 2005 in Baghdad, Iraq, when an IED detonated near his HUMVEE.	Yankton	SD HWY 46 (two miles west of HWY 46 and 81 intersection)
Callies	Tommy L.	Capt	Vietnam	(Air Force) Died August 1, 1969 when his F-4E aircraft crashed into a hillside after dropping its munitions.	Howard	SD HWY 34 (mile marker 366/83) - east edge of Howard
Gatton	David R.	PFC	Vietnam	(Army) Killed on December 29, 1966 in Vietnam. Laid down cover fire for his team to fall back. Killed while attempting to rejoin his team.	Murdo	Big White River Bridge on SD HWY 83 - south of Murdo
Haider	James	SGT	Vietnam	(Army) Killed on June 9, 1968 received fatal fragment wounds when his unit came under intense enemy mortar attack near the village of Nuoc Dang (approximately 32 miles south of Quang Ngai City in Quang Ngai Province, Republic of South Vietnam.	Watertown	Big Sioux River Bridge on SD HWY 212 (15-181-180)
Hutchison	John W.	Cpl	Vietnam	(Marine) Killed on August 19, 1968 in Vietnam, when his helicopter was hit by indirect fire while on an extraction mission.	Presho	White River Bridge on SD HWY 183 - about 15 miles south of Presho (Where White River divides Lyman and Tripp Counties)
Maynard	Richard R.	SGT	Vietnam	(Army) Killed March 20, 1969 by Artillery/mortar fire, while serving in Vietnam.	Dupree	Bridge near Dupree
Schroeder	Frederic	PVT	WWI	(Army) Killed in action September 30, 1918, while serving with B-Company 361st Infantry Regiment 91st Division.	Egan	Big Sioux River Bridge on SD HWY 34 - one mile east of Egan
Bridge	Wayne	S2	WWII	(Navy) Missing in Acting - Presumed Dead. USS Indianapolis (CA-35) sunk by torpedo from a Japanese Submarine - July 30, 1945.	Wagner	Bridge near Wagner
Farlee	Frederick	PFC	WWII	(Army) Multiple fragment wounds, was wounded on April 2, 1945 and later (April 15, 1945) died of wounds.	Lantry	SD HWY 212 (mile marker 144) - two miles west of Lantry
Otto	August	PVT	WWII	(Army) Killed in action at Attu Island May 18, 1943.	Claire City	West Bound Lane on SD HWY 106 - between Claire City and Hammer
