# SOUTH DAKOTA AERONAUTICS COMMISSION MEETING Thursday, September 16, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. CDT via conference call

Chairman Eric Odenbach called the meeting of the South Dakota Aeronautics Commission (the "Commission") to order at 2:00 p.m. CDT. A roll call was taken, and a quorum was determined.

Odenbach opened the floor to the Commission to disclose potential conflicts of interest and to present requests for waiver pursuant to the South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) Chapter 3-23.

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Odenbach presented an annual disclosure and a waiver received from Vice-chairman Bob Huggins concerning potential conflict of interest. A copy of the request for waiver is attached to and incorporated into these minutes as **Attachment A.** Huggins accepted a teaching position at Lake Area Technical Institute starting in the Fall 2021 semester.

Commissioner Rieber elected to abstain from the vote due to possible conflict of interest due to a connection with Lake Area Technical Institute.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Funk and seconded by Luers that the matters disclosed in the annual disclosure and waiver request are fair, reasonable, and not contrary to public interest. All present voted aye by roll call vote, except Huggins and Rieber, who abstained. The motion carried.

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Commission Christopher Funk left the meeting at 2:04 p.m.

Odenbach asked for a motion to approve the August 19, 2021 Commission meeting minutes.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Huggins and seconded by Rieber to approve the August 19, 2021 Commission meeting minutes. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

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Funk rejoined the meeting at 2:06 p.m.

Odenbach opened the floor to public input. No member of the public address the Commission or offered input.

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Secretary Joel Jundt of the Department of Transportation (the "Department") presented the Secretary's Report. Jundt shared that no decision has been made by the U.S. Congress regarding the Federal Reauthorization and Appropriation bills and that he anticipates that another continuing resolution will go into place on October 1, 2021, until the needed bills can be passed.

Jon Becker, Office of Air, Rail, and Transit, presented the following 2021 Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant to the Commission for consideration.

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### Sioux Falls 3-46-0050-057-2021

- Design of Runway: 15-33(8,000'X150', Concrete) to Taxiway B5 and Reconstruction
- Design of Taxiway: A (6,400'X75', Concrete), A1 (300'x75', Concrete), A3 (250'x75' Asphalt), A5 (275'x75', Asphalt) and Rehabilitation, D (750'x50', Asphalt) Reconstruction and Realignment, F (400'x500' Asphalt) with Reconstruction and M (1,490'x75', Concrete) with Rehabilitation.
- **Construction of Taxiway:** B (3,400x75', Concrete), B4 (300'x75', Concrete) and B5 (340'x75', Concrete) with Rehabilitation
- Acquire and Install: Two Passenger Boarding Bridges for Gates 4 and 6.
- Removal of Taxiway: Airport Hot Spot "E"

Mark Weiderrich from KLJ Engineering explained the details of the project and answered questions from the Commission.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Funk and Seconded by Luers to approve the Sioux Fall AIP project on Attachment #3. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

Becker presented to the Commission an amendment to the state match portion of a 2018 AIP project in Mobridge. The federal grant amount increased for the Mobridge Municipal Airport AIP project #3-46-0038-12-2018 to cover allotted time frames for additional work and to close out the grant. The Department recommends approval of state assistance in the amendment to the project for an additional amount of \$123.95.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Rieber and seconded by Huggins to approve the state match amendment to AIP project #3-46-0038-12-2018 at the Mobridge Municipal Airport. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

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Tom Koch, Office of Air, Rail, and Transit, presented to the Commission a request for funds from the City of Groton to help offset the cost of the airport runway improvements. To accommodate a better variety of aircraft and to ensure clear approaches in the future, the City of Groton has reconstructed the runway at the Groton Municipal Airport. Most of the project was accomplished by volunteer labor except the fine grading, which was done by a construction contractor utilizing GPS grading equipment. The project was completed at a total cost of \$11,788.27. The City is requesting 75% reimbursement for fuel, seeding, and fine grading.

As per *South Dakota Aeronautics Commission Policies and Procedures* for use of state funds, paragraph D1, the Groton Municipal Airport meets the criteria for state funding. The Department recommends the approval for 75% state participation in the total of \$8,841.20 to the City of Groton.

Darrell Hillestad, Groton Airport Board member, and Terry Herron, Groton Airport Manager, explained the details of the project and answered questions from the Commission.

A MOTION WAS MADE by Luers and seconded by Nelson to approve the request for 75% state participation reimbursement for a total of \$8,841.20 to the City of Groton for their runway reconstruction project. All present voted aye by roll call vote. The motion carried.

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With no other business to come before the Commission, Odenbach adjourned the meeting at 2:32 p.m. CDT.
