Dear Mr. Behm:

The following items are recommended for Commission consideration:

 Request Transportation Commission approval to transfer by resolution and deed to Minnehaha County the following former SD264 property acquired for highway right of way: (See attachment)

Former SD264 is located in Minnehaha County from the east right of way line of SD11 thence east to the Minnesota state line, a total length of approximately six miles.

The above transfer completes Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement #612145 signed by Minnehaha County on December 29, 1998 and DOT on January 11, 1999.

DOT Mitchell Region and Sioux Falls Area advises the above property is no longer needed for highway purposes and transfer is recommended.

2. Request Transportation Commission approval to dispose of the following DOT properties in accordance with the procedures provided by SDCL 31-2-27 and ARSD chapter 10:02:01.

Lot A in Tract W in the E1/2 NE1/4 of Section 6, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the B.H.M., Meade County, South Dakota. (contains 13.35 acres)

Appraised Value: \$342,000

Tract B of the SW1/4 SE1/4 and Tract BW of the SE1/4 SE1/4; all in Section 31, Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the B.H.M., Meade County, South Dakota. (contains 5.52 acres)

Appraised Value: \$83,000

Lot B in the E1/2 NE1/4 of Section 6, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the B.H.M., Meade County, South Dakota. (contains 0.26 acre)

Appraised Value: \$24,000

The above properties are located south of Summerset on the east side of I90 near Exit 51 and are excess from DOT project IM-PH 0901(61)49, PCN 5586.

Lot B contains a natural gas facility and will be sold to the WBIEnergy gas transportation company to complete a project utility relocation agreement.

The properties are mostly rolling hills and electricity is available nearby. Water and sewer are not located on-site. The properties are located within Summerset city limits and zoned C-1 General Commercial. Access is from adjoining Norman Avenue and Three Flags Lane. No access will be allowed along the section line for at least 330' east of the I-90 ROW.

Rapid City Region and Area DOT requests the property disposals.

- 3. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Brule County Project P 0050(93)222, PCN 025A. The project was 9.2 miles of SD50 from the Buffalo and Brule County line to K Avenue in Chamberlain. Construction included milling, AC resurfacing and pipe.
- 4. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Corson County Project ER 1806(08)371, PCN 02M2. The project was SD1806P bank stabilization and repair at Oak Creek adjacent to Wakpala Spur Road (MRM 371.00).
- 5. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Deuel and Hamlin County's Project P 0028(30)354, PCN 02B8. The project was 0.4 mile of SD28 through Estelline and Toronto. Construction included curb ramp upgrades.
- 6. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Hanson and Minnehaha County's Project PH 0020(201), PCN 06JF. The project was 3.1 miles of various locations in the Mitchell Region. Construction included modifying Hwys 34, 38 and 81 intersections.
- 7. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Harding County Project BRF 0079(67)169, PCN 02A2. The SD79 project was over the Grand River located 6.5 miles north of the SD20 junction. Construction included structure replacement and scour protection.
- 8. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Hutchinson County Project P 0018(134)394, PCN 6162. The project was 0.7 mile from the west city limits to the east city limits in Menno. Construction included urban grading, curb and gutter, storm sewer, roadway lighting and AC surfacing.
- 9. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on McCook County Project NH 0081(85)61, PCN 01KV. The project was 1 mile of SD81 from SD38 in Salem to the north city limits. Construction included milling and AC resurfacing, sidewalk and ADA upgrades.
- 10. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Roberts County Project P 0123(08)172, PCN 01T6. The project was 10.5 miles of SD123 from the US12 junction to Wilmot and SD15 one mile east of Wilmot. Construction included milling and AC resurfacing, culverts and pipe replacements.


- 11. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Minnehaha County Project P-PH 0038(27)348, PCN H034. The project was 15.3 miles of SD38 from the junction of SD19 to the beginning of the divided highway at Sioux Falls. Construction included milling and AC resurfacing, ADA, and adding turn lanes.
- 12. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Pennington County Project PH 1614(01), PCN 01DE. The project was 1 mile of Radar Hill Road from 228th Street to 229th Street. Construction included grading, asphalt and concrete surfacing.
- 13. Request Transportation Commission approval to abandon by resolution the temporary easements on Yankton County Project PH-P 0052(02)342, PCN 6700. The project was 0.5 mile of SD52 from Chalkstone Road to Summit Street in Yankton. Construction included milling and AC resurfacing, signals upgrades and intersection reconfiguration.




ROW Item #1 Overview Map

AGREEMENT NUMBER 612145

This agreement, hereinafter referred to as AGREEMENT, by and between the State of South Dakota, acting by and through the South Dakota Department of Transportation, Transportation Commission, hereinafter referred to as STATE, and the County of Minnehaha, South Dakota, acting by and through the Minnehaha County Commission, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, for the purpose of constructing or re-constructing segments of highways and re-jurisdiction of specific highway segments to best serve the transportation needs of the STATE and COUNTY.

WHEREAS, STATE transportation projects are programmed in a public document entitled "1999-2003 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program", hereinafter referred to as STIP, and are programmed in STIP by Federal Fiscal Year, hereinafter referred to as FFY, for example: FFY 1999 begins on October 1, 1998 and continues through September 30, 1999, and

WHEREAS, STATE and COUNTY have a mutual interest in re-construction of South Dakota State Trunk Highway 264, hereinafter referred to as SD-264, project P 3264 (00) 424, PCEMS #4492 as programmed in STIP for FFY 1999, from its junction with South Dakota State Trunk Highway 11, hereinafter referred to as SD-11, easterly to the Minnesota state line, a total overall length of approximately six miles and at an estimated cost of One Million Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,850,000.00); hereinafter referred to as PROJECT, as per terms of this AGREEMENT, and

WHEREAS, STATE and COUNTY have a mutual interest in transferring absolute ownership, jurisdiction and continued maintenance responsibility of present SD-264 for public use from the east right-of-way line of SD-11 near the southwest corner of section thirty-five, township one-hundred-two north, range forty-eight west, thence east to the Minnesota state line near the northeast corner of section three, township one-hundred-one north, range forty-seven west, a total length of approximately six miles; hereinafter referred to as SEGMENT, from STATE to COUNTY, as per terms of this AGREEMENT, and

WHEREAS, STATE and COUNTY have a mutual interest in providing compensation in the form of a transition fund payment for added public highway responsibility during the transition period after transfer of jurisdiction of SEGMENT from STATE to COUNTY, as per terms of this AGREEMENT, and

WHEREAS, STATE and COUNTY have a mutual interest in continuing highway route signing on SEGMENT as "SD-264", for a period of three years after transfer of jurisdiction from STATE to COUNTY or as directed by COUNTY, whichever occurs first, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.

NOW, THEREFORE, STATE and COUNTY agree as follows:

A. STATE agrees to perform the following:

- STATE shall allow COUNTY to: design; prepare construction plans, subject to STATE
 concurrence prior to COUNTY solicitation of construction bids; solicit construction bids;
 award construction contract, subject to STATE concurrence; perform construction
 engineering; construct PROJECT in compliance with safety and COUNTY standards and
 specifications; accommodate high volume turning movements where warranted; account
 for and certify all eligible, actual expenses of items, material, equipment and labor incurred
 by COUNTY for PROJECT, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- 2. STATE shall furnish COUNTY any existing information; data; aerial survey or other survey data; hydraulic data; etc.; for PROJECT upon request by and at no expense to COUNTY, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- STATE shall provide a transition fund of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.) for COUNTY, exclusively for use on public highway / bridge maintenance or construction; hereinafter referred to as FUND, in addition to reimbursement for PROJECT, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- 4. STATE shall compensate COUNTY for FUND, subject to audit review, within thirty days after transfer of jurisdiction of SEGMENT from STATE to COUNTY, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- 5. STATE shall have the sole obligation for reimbursement to COUNTY for all eligible expenses incurred by COUNTY for construction of PROJECT, as may be included in any construction contract for PROJECT, except for expenses to acquire additional temporary easements, additional permanent easements and additional right-of-way for PROJECT; shall have no obligation to reimburse COUNTY for any expenses associated with extra work orders or change orders for PROJECT that have not been approved in advance by STATE and shall reimburse COUNTY within thirty days of receipt of periodic reimbursement requests for all eligible, certified, actual expenses for items, material, equipment and labor incurred by COUNTY for PROJECT, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- STATE shall initiate legislation in the 1999 South Dakota State Legislative Session to remove SD-264 from the State Trunk Highway System, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- 7. STATE shall transfer absolute ownership, jurisdiction, operation and continued maintenance responsibility for public use of STATE portion of SEGMENT to COUNTY after SD-264 is removed from the State Trunk Highway System by the South Dakota State Legislature, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.

8. STATE shall provide continued highway route signing on SEGMENT as "SD-264" for a period of three years after transfer of jurisdiction from STATE to COUNTY or as directed otherwise by COUNTY, whichever occurs first, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.

B. COUNTY agrees to perform the following:

- COUNTY shall: design; prepare construction plans, subject to STATE concurrence prior
 to COUNTY solicitation of construction bids; solicit construction bids; award
 construction contract, subject to STATE concurrence; perform construction engineering;
 construct PROJECT as per safety and COUNTY standards and specifications;
 accommodate high volume turning movements where warranted; account for and certify
 all eligible, actual expenses of items, material, equipment and labor incurred by COUNTY
 for PROJECT; and shall, at no expense to STATE, acquire all additional temporary
 easements, permanent easements and highway right-of-way for PROJECT, as per terms of
 this AGREEMENT.
- COUNTY shall request any existing information; data; aerial survey or other survey data; hydraulic data; etc. from STATE for PROJECT at no expense to COUNTY, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- 3. COUNTY shall submit periodic reimbursement requests to STATE, including certification of all eligible, actual expenses for items, material, equipment and labor incurred by COUNTY for PROJECT, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- 4. COUNTY shall expend FUND on public highways or bridges, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- 5. COUNTY shall retain expense records for FUND and PROJECT and make them available on request for audit review up to and including three years after incurred expenses and three years after all terms of this AGREEMENT have been met, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.
- COUNTY shall support STATE initiated legislation before the South Dakota State
 Legislature to remove SD-264 from the State Trunk Highway System, as per terms of this
 AGREEMENT.
- 7. COUNTY shall accept absolute ownership, jurisdiction, operation and continued maintenance responsibilities of SEGMENT for public use from STATE after SD-264 is removed from the State Trunk Highway System by the South Dakota State Legislature, as per terms of this AGREEMENT.

- C. This AGREEMENT is binding upon the signatures hereto not as individuals but solely in their capacities as officials of their respective organizations and acknowledges proper action of STATE and COUNTY to enter the same.
- D. Neither this AGREEMENT nor any interest therein shall be assigned, sublet or transferred unless permission to do so is granted by STATE in writing.
- E. This AGREEMENT shall become effective on the date of signature by the Secretary of Transportation.
- F. The STATE and COUNTY have the option to and right to terminate or cancel the entire AGREEMENT if both parties agree to in writing.
- G. Any dispute concerning this AGREEMENT between the parties hereto shall be referred to the Secretary of Transportation or his duly authorized representative for determination, whose decision in the matter shall be final and conclusive on the parties of this AGREEMENT.
- H. Any act identified in this AGREEMENT and required to be performed on the part of either party hereto, shall be subject to and conditioned upon the due and proper execution of a valid and binding construction contract for work on PROJECT as identified in this AGREEMENT; in that regard, the parties agree to cooperate and use their best efforts so that a bid letting for PROJECT may be scheduled in a timely manner.



Overview Map




Proposed Disposal - Meade County




Proposed TE Abandonment Brule County

















Proposed TE Abandonment - Minnehaha County











Proposed TE Abandonment - Hutchinson County
















Proposed TE Abandonment - Pennington County


