Dear Mr. Behm:

The following items are recommended for Commission consideration:

1. Request Transportation Commission approval to dispose of the following DOT excess right-of-way property in accordance with the procedures provided by SDCL 31-2-27 and ARSD chapter 10:02:01.

Lot H2 in Golden Treasure Fraction of Mineral Survey No. 1198, Pennington County, South Dakota, containing 0.02 acre.

Appraised Value: \$100

Lot H2 is located on the west side of US Hwy 16A approximately one and one-half miles northwest of Keystone. No public access is available due to the property being surrounded by private ownership. Rapid City Area DOT advises Lot H2 is not needed for future department use. (See attachments)

Request Transportation Commission approval to amend control of access language shown on a
Department of Transportation Quit Claim Deed recorded in Book DH, page 232 on September
20, 2011 in Hutchinson County.

Existing deed access reference: "No access will be allowed to or from public right of way from the above-referenced property, other than as may be approved by the Department."

Proposed deed access reference: "No access will be allowed to or from U.S. Highway 81 from the above-referenced property, other than as may be approved by the Department."

The recorded deed access reference restricts access from County and Township roads. A corrective deed with the amended control of access language would allow access other than from U.S. Highway 81.

Yankton Area DOT recommends approval of the deed control of access correction. (See attachments)

3. Request Transportation Commission approval acknowledging the conditions set forth within Resolution 2018-12.04 have been met and satisfied.

The South Dakota Transportation Commission, pursuant to Resolution 2018-12.04, recorded on December 4, 2020, set forth conditions precedent which were required to be met before the State of South Dakota's interest in the following property would be abandoned:

Lot AB1 in a portion of Lot H3 in the SW1/4 of Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 8 East of the B.H.M., City of Box Elder, Pennington County, South Dakota. (contains 3.56 acres)

The above property is no longer needed for highway purposes and abandonment was recommended by DOT Rapid City Area. All of the conditions set forth within Resolution 2018-12.04 have been met and satisfied, this resolution would therefore confirm conditions are now met and abandon said property described above.

4. Abandonment – Buffalo County

This resolution will abandon the temporary easement on Buffalo County Project P 0013(25), PCN 041C.

5. Abandonment - Clark County

This resolution will abandon the temporary easements on Clark County Project P 0013(25), PCN 041C.

6. Abandonment – Lincoln County

This resolution will abandon the temporary easements on Lincoln County Project IM 29-2(61)71, PCN 3167.

7. Abandonment – Pennington County

This resolution will abandon the temporary easements on Pennington County Project P 0231(12)80, PCN 02R5.


