SUBJECT: Sioux Valley Grant Termination

In 2013, the SDDOT entered into an agreement with the USDOT for the Sioux Valley Relocation project. This project had many environmental and cultural challenges that required project evaluations, and grant adjustments. Over the last several years this project has accumulated \$526,574 in consulting fees and land acquisition. To date, there have been zero federal funds disbursed for this project. The expenses incurred were paid by use of a loan and grant approved by the SD Rail Board to the Sioux Valley Regional Rail Authority and promissory note to D&I, and D&I funds. There has been no acquisition of materials or construction to date.

The D&I Railroad Company (subrecipient of the grant) has requested the project be terminated because they believe there are more cost-effective solutions to address the area than continuing with this grant. Please see the attached letter from D&I for more information.

The SDDOT recommends approval of the grant termination. The SDDOT also recommends the loan remain active until the D&I Railroad fully reimburses all associated debt.
