- 70:01:02:26 Edmunds County speed zone rule; and
- 70:01:02:52 Moody County speed zone rule.

- **70:01:02:26. Edmunds County.** The following are the maximum speeds on certain highways in Edmunds County:
- (1) U.S. Highway 12 beginning-<u>0.6 one</u> mile west of the junction of U.S. Highway 12 and State Trunk Highway 45, then east for <u>0.15 0.5</u> mile, <u>45 forty-five</u> miles per hour; then east for 0.9 mile, <u>30 thirty</u> miles per hour; then east for 0.2 mile, <u>45 forty-five</u> miles per hour;
- (2) U.S. Highway 12 beginning 0.7 0.3 mile east of the northeast corner of section 25, township 123 north, range 71 west of the fifth principal meridian 341st Avenue, then west for 0.5 mile, 50 fifty miles per hour; then west for 0.4 mile, 30 thirty miles per hour; then west for 0.2 mile, 50 fifty miles per hour;
- (3) State Trunk Highway 45 in Ipswich beginning at the junction of U.S. Highway 12 and State Trunk Highway 45, then south from the junction 0.64 <u>0.6</u> mile, <u>30 thirty</u> miles per hour; then south for <u>0.22 0.2</u> mile, <u>40 forty</u> miles per hour;
- (4) State Trunk Highway 247 in Roscoe beginning at the junction of U.S. Highway 12 and State Trunk Highway 247, then north 0.48 0.5 mile, 25 twenty-five miles per hour; then north 0.2 mile, 45 forty-five miles per hour; then north to the McPherson-Edmunds county line, 55 fifty-five miles per hour;
- (5) U.S. Highway 12 through Bowdle beginning 0.4 mile west of the beginning of the divided section, then east for 2.17 2.2 miles, 55 fifty-five miles per hour; and
- (6) State Trunk Highway 134 beginning at the Edmunds-Brown county line, then west 0.19 mile, 55 miles per hour; then west 0.83 mile, 50 miles per hour; then west and south to the junction of U.S. Highway 12, 55 miles per hour;

(7) State Trunk Highway 253 beginning 8.99 nine miles north of the junction with U.S

Highway 12, then west 0.24 0.2 mile, 45 forty-five miles per hour; then west 0.68 mile through

Hosmer, 25 twenty-five miles per hour; then west 0.2 mile, 45 forty-five miles per hour.

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70:01:02:52. Moody County. The following are the maximum speeds on certain highways in Moody County:

- (1) State Trunk Highway 34 beginning <u>0.17_0.2</u> mile southwesterly of First Street in Egan, then northeasterly for <u>0.15_0.2</u> mile, <u>50_fifty</u> miles per hour; then northeasterly for <u>one-half_0.5</u> mile, <u>35_thirty-five</u> miles per hour; then northeasterly for <u>0.15_0.2</u> mile, <u>50_fifty</u> miles per hour;
- (2) State Trunk Highway 34 beginning at the section line road, 0.75 mile west of Main Street in Colman, then east 0.24 0.2 mile, 45 forty-five miles per hour; then east 0.85 0.9 mile, 35 thirty-five miles per hour; then east 0.35 0.4 mile, 45 forty-five miles per hour;
- (3) State Trunk Highway 13 beginning 0.51 0.5 mile south of State Trunk Highway 32 (Pipestone Avenue) in Flandreau, then north 0.175 0.2 mile to Broad Avenue, 45 forty-five miles per hour; then north 0.49 0.5 mile 25, twenty-five miles per hour; then north 0.175 0.2 mile, 45 forty-five miles per hour;
- (4) State Trunk Highway 32 beginning—0.15_0.2 mile west of Industrial Road, then east to Industrial Road,—45 forty-five miles per hour; then east—0.26_0.3 mile to Veteran Street,—35 thirty-five miles per hour; then east—1.02 miles one mile through Flandreau to State Trunk Highway 13 (Summit Street),—25 twenty-five miles per hour;
- (5) State Trunk Highway 32 over Interstate Highway 29 at Exit 114 beginning at a point 0.2 mile west of the centerline of Interstate Highway 29, then east 0.4 mile, 40 forty miles per hour; and
- (6) State Trunk Highway 34 beginning <u>0.32 0.4</u> mile west of the centerline of Interstate Highway 29, then east <u>0.75 0.7</u> mile, <u>55 forty-five</u> miles per hour.
