Conference check-in and opening ceremony take place on Tuesday afternoon and evening, September 12th at the Oregon Historical Society, and will continue Wednesday, Thursday and Friday at the Native American Student and Community Center o campus at Portland State University in downtown Portland. Conference

topics will include workshops, meetings, and presentations from local, state, and federal partners (continuing education credits will be available for State Names Authorities). The USBGN will hold a meeting on Friday, as will the Oregon Geographic Names Board. Saturday's toponymic session will focus on nearby Columbia River and Portland-area history and geography.
