Call to Order/Welcome and Introductions: Ball called the meeting to order at 8:31am MDT.

Roll Call: Tellinghuisen Geddes called the roll. Ball, yes; Ashokar, yes; Roegiers, yes; Stanage, yes; Dosch, yes; McParland, yes; Boyer, yes. A quorum was present.

Corrections or Additions to the Agenda: None.

FY Financial Update: Tellinghuisen Geddes reported year-end financials: revenue of \$71,630.97 expenses of \$67,559.76 and a cash balance of \$152,079.59.

Annual Review of Open Meeting Laws (SDCL 1-25-13): Tishkoff presented an overview of the Guide to South Dakota's Open Meeting Laws, prepared by the Attorney General's Office as required by SDCL 1-25-13. There were no questions from the Board.

Renewal Update: Tellinghuisen-Geddes reported six psychologists did not renew their license this year for the June 30, 2026, deadline.

PSYPACT UPDATE: Ball reported that 46 states are now part of PSYPACT. Iowa is joining effective July 2027, and Alaska will join in September 2026. Ball is set to attend the Annual Meeting in November in Nashville.

Upcoming ASPPB Meetings: Tellinghuisen Geddes reported that Dr. Trisha Miller is set to attend the upcoming Annual Meeting in Reno, Nevada in October to represent the Board.

Schedule Next Meeting: The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for Friday, December 4, 2026, at 8:30 MST/9:30 CST via Microsoft Teams.

Executive Session Pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2: The Board did not have a need to enter Executive Session.

Complaint Report: There are no pending complaints and no dismissed complaints by the investigative committee to report.

Any other business: Tellinghuisen Geddes reported that Dr. Burnetti-Atwell with ASPPB, who attended the last Board meeting, has announced her retirement effective April 2027. Additionally, the Board thanked Dr. Stanage, who will be terming out of his board member position in October, for his years of service to the Board of Examiners of Psychologists.

1-27-1.17. Draft minutes of public meeting to be available--Exceptions--Violation as misdemeanor. The unapproved, draft minutes of any public meeting held pursuant to § 1-25-1 that are required to be kept by law shall be available for inspection by any person within ten business days after the meeting. However, this section does not apply if an audio or video recording of the meeting is available to the public on the governing body's website within five business days after the meeting. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor. However, the provisions of this section do not apply to draft minutes of contested case proceedings held in accordance with the provisions of chapter 1-26.
