INSTITUTE TO COLLEGE NAME CHANGE

HB 1083 became law on July 1, thus changing the names of the state's four technical **institutes** to technical **colleges**. This change better aligns our system with the majority of other states across the country. The name change does not change the mission of the colleges.







DUAL-CREDIT PROGRAM UPDATE

Senator Brock Greenfield (R-Clark) introduced three bills impacting the high school dual-credit program in 2020. **SB 142** passed and went into effect on July 1.

SB 142 would prohibit students who withdraw or fail a dual-credit course from continuing participation in the program.

The bill was amended to allow the Board of Regents and the Board of Technical Education to consider a student's "good cause" claim and continue participation.

Both systems developed a consistent policy/waiver and both boards approved the policy during their June meetings.
