Allan Sage is, at minimum, a Class I Water Treatment Operator and a Class I Water Distribution Operator certified by the South Dakota Department of Agricultural and Natural Resources and is an employee of Sage Water Works, Inc. Allan Sage is designated as the employee in charge of services under this contract.

SECTION II

DESCRIPTION OF THE SYSTEM:

The Water Association is the owner of the water system consisting of two (2) water wells (one primary/one backup), one (1) reservoir, water mains and lines known as the Addie Camp Water & Septic Association, Inc. formerly known as Prairie Berry Winery water system" Water System with registered EPA ID No. 2274. The system's water source is ground water and has fourteen (14) user service connections at the time of the signing of this agreement. Drinking water is treated with chlorine, soda ash and is not treated with phosphates or fluoride.

The system does not include and specifically excludes all water lines, appliances, facilities, hydrants and points of use on the consumer side of the water main for each respective user.

SECTION III

PURPOSE:

The Operator is a certified water system operator and in the business of operating water systems for private associations. The Water Association is the owner of the water system and requires the service of a licensed operator to manage its water system.

All new agreements are subject to amendment until approved by the "South Dakota Board of Operator Certification".

SECTION IV

DUTIES OF THE OPERATOR:

During the term of this contract, the Operator shall perform any and all services required on Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

The termination and restoration of a residence water supply for nonpayment to the Water Association is not a part of the general services rendered in Exhibit A and will be rendered at the request of the Water Association for additional fee(s).

During the term of this contract, the Operator shall be in direct responsible charge of all operations and maintenance of the water system and the Water Association shall not permit any interference with the same.

DUTIES OF THE WATER ASSOCIATION:

The Water Association shall provide all requested water system and housing community information necessary for Certified Operator to manage the water system including, but not limited to, any and all "as built" plans and maps of the water system, manuals and specifications for the pump, reservoir and water system and an inventory of spare parts and equipment for the same. The Water Association shall further provide and pay for all repairs necessary to the water system in order to maintain the same and shall make such repairs and enhancements as are necessary to provide safe drinking water or required by the Department of Agricultural and Natural Resources for maintenance of its certification as a water system. The Water Association will make every effort to notify the Certified Operator of any planned or unplanned work to be performed on the water system.

SECTION V

COMPENSATION:

The Water Association shall pay to the Certified Operator for its services the sum of \$1,375.00 per month plus applicable tax for general services. All water testing and water treatment chemicals must be purchased through Sage Water Works, Inc.

The Certified Operator's fee may be adjusted annually based upon the number of additional service connections, wells, and/or increases in operational expenses. Written notice of any such increase will not be less than 30 days.

Payments are due by the 28th of every month. Payments not received by the 28th of the month or when applicable the adjusted due date will have late charges assessed.

SECTION VI

TERM AND EXTENSION:

This contract shall commence on the date hereof and shall continue for a period of one (1) year to the anniversary date hereof. This agreement will automatically renew for an additional year unless the Water Association or the Certified Operator gives written notice to the other not later than sixty (60) days prior to the end of the term of its intention to terminate this agreement. All of the terms and conditions of the agreement applicable hereto shall continue in full force and effect for the additional term.

INSURANCE:

The Certified Operator agrees to maintain Worker's Compensation and Employer Liability insurance coverage throughout the term of this agreement as such Worker's Compensation insurance is required from time to time by the laws of the State of South Dakota, holding the Water Association harmless from any claims by the employees of Operator.

The Water Association agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Certified Operator from any and all claims including, but not limited to, loss of property, theft or legal action as the result of error and/or negligence by the Water Association, its officers, directors, engineers, consultants and agents.

The Certified Operator agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Water Association from any and all claims including, but not limited to, loss of property, theft or legal action as the result of error and/or negligence by the Certified Operator, its officers, directors, engineers, consultants and agents.

SECTION VIII

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PARTIES:

The Water Association contracts with the Certified Operator as an independent contractor and solely for the purposes set forth in this agreement. The Certified Operator shall be free to determine the time, energy and skill required for the performance of the contract and shall be free to schedule such time and service in such manner as the contractor sees fit. The Certified Operator contractor shall not be considered as an employee, joint venture or partner in the operation, maintenance and service of the water system.

The Water Association and Certified Operator shall conduct business in a professional manner at all times and respect each other as business entities with individual operating standards.

SECTION IX

RESPONSIBILITY:

Certified Operator shall perform its services through certified/qualified personnel in a good and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the generally accepted safety practices.

SECTION X

TERMINATION:

- A. <u>Termination Without Cause</u>. Either party hereto may terminate this agreement without cause upon sixty (60) days written notice of termination delivered to the affected party by first class mail.
- B. <u>Death or Disability</u>. This agreement may be terminated by the Operator or Water Association upon thirty (30) days written notice in the event the services required of the Certified Operator cannot be performed by it due to the death, disability, relocation or military service of its Certified Operator and inability to provide a substitute or replacement of the same in order to complete the term of this agreement.

C. <u>Termination for Breach</u>. OPERATOR'S CONTRACT: CLASS I OPERATOR

SECTION I

PARTIES:

The parties to this agreement are Sage Water Works, Inc., Allan Sage Certified Operator of 5310 Ebony Place, Piedmont, SD 57769, herein called "Operator" and Weston Heights Homeowners Association of Rapid City, South Dakota, herein called "Water Association."

Allan Sage is, at minimum, a Class I Water Treatment Operator and a Class I Water Distribution Operator certified by the South Dakota Department of Agricultural and Natural Resources and is an employee of Sage Water Works, Inc. Allan Sage is designated as the employee in charge of services under this contract.

SECTION II

DESCRIPTION OF THE SYSTEM:

The Water Association is the owner of the water system consisting of two (2) water wells, one (1) reservoir, water mains and lines known as the Weston Heights Homeowners Association Water System with registered EPA ID No. 0862. The system's water source is ground water and has one hundred and forty-nine (149) user service connections at the time of the signing of this agreement. Drinking water is treated with chlorine and is not treated with phosphates or fluoride.

The system does not include and specifically excludes all water lines, appliances, facilities, hydrants and points of use on the consumer side of the water main for each respective user.

SECTION III

PURPOSE:

The Operator is a certified water system operator and in the business of operating water systems for private associations. The Water Association is the owner of the water system and requires the service of a licensed operator to manage its water system.

All new agreements are subject to amendment until approved by the "South Dakota Board of Operator Certification".

SECTION IV

DUTIES OF THE OPERATOR:

During the term of this contract, the Operator shall perform any and all services required on Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

The termination and restoration of a residence water supply for nonpayment to the Water Association is not a part of the general services rendered in Exhibit A and will be rendered at the request of the Water Association for additional fee(s).

During the term of this contract, the Operator shall be in direct responsible charge of all operations and maintenance of the water system and the Water Association shall not permit any interference with the same.

DUTIES OF THE WATER ASSOCIATION:

The Water Association shall provide all requested water system and housing community information necessary for Certified Operator to manage the water system including, but not limited to, any and all "as built" plans and maps of the water system, manuals and specifications for the pump, reservoir and water system and an inventory of spare parts and equipment for the same. The Water Association shall further provide and pay for all repairs necessary to the water system in order to maintain the same and shall make such repairs and enhancements as are necessary to provide safe drinking water or required by the Department of Agricultural and Natural Resources for maintenance of its certification as a water system. The Water Association will make every effort to notify the Certified Operator of any planned or unplanned work to be performed on the water system.

SECTION V

COMPENSATION:

The Water Association shall pay to the Certified Operator for its services the sum of \$550.00 per month plus applicable tax for general services. All water testing and water treatment chemicals must be purchased through Sage Water Works, Inc.

The Certified Operator's fee may be adjusted annually based upon the number of additional service connections, wells, and/or increases in operational expenses. Written notice of any such increase will not be less than 30 days.

Payments are due by the 28th of every month. Payments not received by the 28th of the month or when applicable the adjusted due date will have late charges assessed.

SECTION VI

TERM AND EXTENSION:

This contract shall commence on the date hereof and shall continue for a period of one (1) year to the anniversary date hereof. This agreement will automatically renew for an additional year unless the Water Association or the Certified Operator gives written notice to the other not later than sixty (60) days prior to the end of the term of its intention to terminate this agreement. All of the terms and conditions of the agreement applicable hereto shall continue in full force and effect for the additional term.

INSURANCE:

The Certified Operator agrees to maintain Worker's Compensation and Employer Liability insurance coverage throughout the term of this agreement as such Worker's Compensation insurance is required from time to time by the laws of the State of South Dakota, holding the Water Association harmless from any claims by the employees of Operator.

The Water Association agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Certified Operator from any and all claims including, but not limited to, loss of property, theft or legal action as the result of error and/or negligence by the Water Association, its officers, directors, engineers, consultants and agents.

The Certified Operator agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Water Association from any and all claims including, but not limited to, loss of property, theft or legal action as the result of error and/or negligence by the Certified Operator, its officers, directors, engineers, consultants and agents.

SECTION VIII

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PARTIES:

The Water Association contracts with the Certified Operator as an independent contractor and solely for the purposes set forth in this agreement. The Certified Operator shall be free to determine the time, energy and skill required for the performance of the contract and shall be free to schedule such time and service in such manner as the contractor sees fit. The Certified Operator contractor shall not be considered as an employee, joint venture or partner in the operation, maintenance and service of the water system.

The Water Association and Certified Operator shall conduct business in a professional manner at all times and respect each other as business entities with individual operating standards.

SECTION IX

RESPONSIBILITY:

Certified Operator shall perform its services through certified/qualified personnel in a good and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the generally accepted safety practices.

SECTION X

TERMINATION:

- A. <u>Termination Without Cause</u>. Either party hereto may terminate this agreement without cause upon sixty (60) days written notice of termination delivered to the affected party by first class mail.
- B. Death or Disability. This agreement may be terminated by the Operator or Water Association upon thirty (30) days written notice in the event the services required of the Certified Operator cannot be performed by it due to the death, disability, relocation or military service of its Certified Operator and inability to provide a substitute or replacement of the same in order to complete the term of this agreement.
- C. <u>Termination for Breach</u>. In the event of a material breach by one party, the non-breaching party may provide written notice of the breach and terminate this agreement at any time after a reasonable opportunity to cure such breach. Such opportunity not to exceed thirty (30) days. If the breaching party, prior to expiration of such period, has cured the breach, this agreement shall remain in effect for the balance of its current term.

The following outlines the water operation contract between KOA Hill City/Needles Highway and Dakota Pump Inc. for the KOA Hill City/Needles Highway Water System.

Section 1) Parties Involved

- 2. Trevor holds certificates for Water Treatment State of SD and Water Distribution State of SD
- 3. The system we will be working on for this contract is the KOA Hill City/Needles Highway water system (EPA# 2253).

Section 2) Description of the System

The KOA Hill City/Needles Highway Water System is located on highway 87 outside of Hill City. They are a campground with a fluctuating population dependent on how busy they are. They would be considered a seasonal system. The source of the system is ground water. The treatment present is chlorination, softening and Filtration. The water is then distributed to the rest of the system.

Section 3) Purpose of the Contract

KOA Hill City/Needles Highway is currently in need of a system operator that has a qualified certification. KOA Hill City/Needles Highway needs sampling, testing, and reporting.

Section 4) Duties of the Contract Operator

Dakota Pump Inc. will charge a flat rate to collect and submit all water system samples that are required for the year. For this year that means Dakota Pump Inc. will from May 1st moving forward take all the samples for BCT, Lead and Copper, THC, VOC, Nitrate, and SOC or others required by the state. We will take samples and deliver them to the lab. BCT testing for each month is not included in our price. Any other testing that is required by the state will be paid directly to the Lab.

Dakota Pump Inc will take Chlorine residual measurements and help to adjust distribution to maintain a level of at least .3mg/l in all areas of the system. We will be doing weekly onsite visits of the well/booster house and chem feed system. The goal is to help maintain efficient systems operation.

Dakota Pump will also do a system start up and the beginning of the camping season. This fee will be in addition to the monthly cost of operation.

Upgrades and improvements will be agreed to in separate quotes outside of this contract based on specific needs at that time. Anything outside of taking samples, testing, and weekly onsite visits will be addressed at the rates shown in Section 5 of this document. Dakota Pump Inc will maintain an employee with a valid operator's certificate while this contract is in effect. Any on-site work or construction can be discussed but is not covered in this contract.

Section 5) Payment Amount

A monthly fee of \$350 plus tax will be billed for sampling and weekly visits. Anything outside the sampling, testing, and normal weekly visits will be billed at an hourly rate of \$150 per hour per man plus equipment and materials. The \$150 per hour is for normal business hours that are 8am to 5pm Monday through Friday. Anything outside that time frame will be billed at \$185 per hour per man. Jobs or system

The Association will make payment to the Contract Operator on or before the 10th of each month for Services performed and expenses invoiced during the billing period.

Section 7 - Dates

Operations Staffing

Joe Barrett will serve as the certified operator for PHP CID wastewater treatment plant and water treatment plant. Joe has over 20 years of wastewater and water operations experience and holds a Level IV wastewater treatment and Level III water treatment certifications, which exceeds the needed Level III wastewater treatment and Level I water treatment certifications needed for PHP CID permits.

PHP CID wastewater treatment facility is located at 21282 Rubys Way, Lead SD and the Water Treatment Facility is located at 21475 Englewood Road, Lead SD.

Kent Wince, PHP CID District Manager and Tony Merkel, PHP CID Operations Manager, will be the onsite contacts and operate both facilities under Joe Barrett's guidance. Their office location is 11283 Powderhouse Trail, Lead SD. Kent Wince holds Level I wastewater treatment and Level I water treatment certifications.

Systems

PHP CID Wastewater Treatment Facility services 150 connections, and utilizes screening, flow equalization, activated sludge with secondary clarifier including extended aeration, chemical/physical treatment without secondary treatment, sludge storage basins, and on-site UV disinfectant treatment.

PHP CID Water Treatment Facility utilizes chlorine disinfection and bag filtration (Fil-Trek Cartridges -- 50 micron / 1 micron) for treatment of surface water provided by Lead Deadwood Sanitary District.

Contract Purpose

JB will be in direct charge of PHP CID Wastewater & Water Treatment Facilities until PHP CID staff have achieved needed certifications. PHP CID Wastewater Facility requires Level III certification and Water Treatment Facility requires Level I certification. Kent Wince, PHP CID District Manager, currently holds Level I wastewater treatment & water treatment certifications. The contract length will be from July 1, 2025, to July 1, 2026, providing PHP CID staff achieve needed certifications. If not, the contract will be extended until July 1, 2027.

Contract operation fee of \$3,000.00 per month will be invoiced to PHP CID by the 15th of each month and payable upon receipt.

Scope of Service Wastewater

JB will be in direct responsible charge and will provide the following routine system operations services at the PHP CID Wastewater Treatment Facility.

- Supervise system personnel and their work activities
- Operate and maintain wastewater system
