

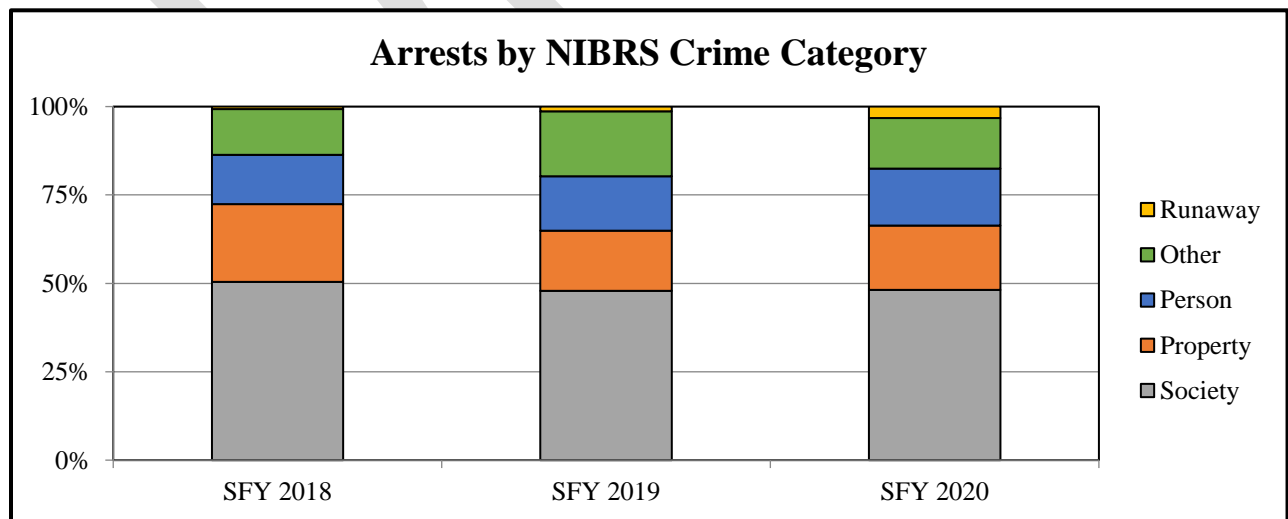

**2. Arrests by NIBRS Crime Category**



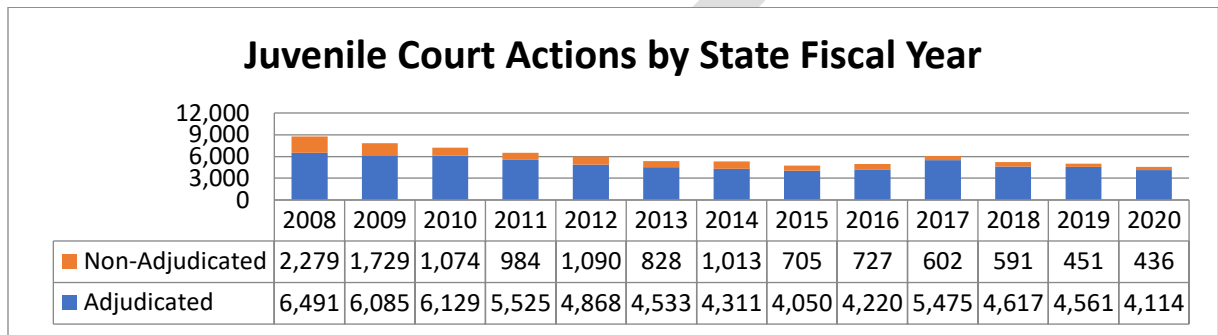
