### **Description:**

"A" is the robe, "B" is the cloak, and "C" is the robe front. Three piece Philippine archbishop robe consisting of three parts. All three pieces have cloth backing and embroidery of gilt and brass thread. Floral and curvilinear designs. Robe is green velvet without sleeves, snap top front, and embroidered lapel area. Embroidered front and back. Cloak is made of a green-brown ribbon-like cloth. The threads resemble grass fibers. Cloak has scalloped edges. Robe front is a light brown and rectangular. It is also made from a ribbon-like material. It has brass thread fringe around borders. Has blood stains on parts of the robe.



### **Description:**

Obverse: TH JEFFERSON PRESIDENT OF THE U.S. A. D. 1801 etched into the medal, circling an image of

Jefferson.

Reverse: PEACE AND FRIENDSHIP etched into the center; under 'peace' is an image of a peace pipe and tomahawk crossed; under 'and' is an image of 2 clasped hands shaking = friendship. One hand shows a military cuff with three braided chevrons = American government, other shows a silver band w/ a beaded border and engraved American eagle = Indian.

### Reason for Deaccession:

Taken from a Native American grave, falls under grave goods under NAGPRA and is subject to repatriation.
